Wednesday Sept 21st These 24 hours commences with light breezes from W. by N. and pleasant weather, at 1 P.M. calms a squall at 10 P.M. fresh breezes from N.W. reefed the main-sail, Middle parts variable with squally weather, latter parts fine breezes with pleasant weather all sail set to the best advantage. Lat 46.35. D R 35.00

Thursday Sept 22nd These 24 hours commences with fine breezes from N.W. with pleasant weather at 5 P.M. jibed ship's fresh breezes from W. N.W. Middle parts variable, at 1 A.M. took in the square-sail and set the jib. latter parts more moderate discovered the well was half full of water by the leak being stopped at 10 A.M. set the main-sail, ends pleasant the wind N.W. Lat 46.35.24 D R 35.10.

Friday Sept 23rd These 24 hours commences with light airs from S.W. with pleasant weather, a heavy swell at 3 P.M. arose at 11 P.M. moderate breezes from N.E. latter parts fine pleasant breezes at 7 A.M. set the square sail ends pleasant wind N.E. all sail set. Lat 46.40.04 D R 35.51.

Saturday Sept 24th These 24 hours commences with fine breezes from N.W. with pleasant weather, Middle parts moderate gales at 4 midnight reefed the main-sail, at 4 A.M. fresh gales took in the main-sail run under the square-sail, latter parts more moderate with squalls of rain, ends pleasant at meridian set the main-sail the wind west. Lat 46.41.34 D R 41.21

Sunday Sept 25th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from west with pleasant weather, Middle parts light airs and calm at 11 P.M. lowered down the main-sail at 1 A.M. light breezes from N.W. jibed ship, and set the main-sail, latter parts fresh breezes with a ruff sea, ends the wind N.W. and cloudy. No Ck this day Lat by D R 46.01.5

Monday Sept 26th These 24 hours commences with moderate gales, and cloudy weather, at 3 P.M. the wind hauled suddenly to the west attended with rain, jibed ship and took in the main-sail, and run under the square-sail. Middle parts more moderate, a ruff sea, latter parts fine breezes at 5 A.M. set the main-sail, at 7 hauled out the reefs, ends pleasant wind west. Lat 46.42.35 D R 42.50

Tuesday Sept 27th These 24 hours commences with fine breezes from N.W. with pleasant weather, and a ruff sea at half past midnight took in the main-sail, Middle parts more moderate, latter parts light breezes, at 8 A.M. fresh reefed the main-sail and set it ends strong breezes and pleasant, Lat 46.43.47. D R 43.42.

Wednesday Sept 28th These 24 hours commences with fine breezes from S.W. attended with squalls of snow, at 4 P.M. fresh took in the main-sail and set the key-sail, Middle parts more moderate, latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. and pleasant weather. Lat 46.45.17 D R 45.22

Thursday Sept 29th These 24 hours commences with moderate gales from S.W. running before it under the square-sail at 6 P.M. fresh squalls of wind and snow took in the square-sail, and have to under the key-sail Middle parts more moderate, latter parts squally at 3 A.M. carried away the jib stay and set the jib ends fresh breezes with squalls of snow. Lat 46.45.44 D R 45.41.5

Friday Sept 30th These 24 hours commences with fresh gales from W. N.W. attended with snow squalls running under the key-sail and jib. Middle parts the same, latter parts more moderate, at 1 P.M. set the square-sail, at 11 set the main-sail reefed, ends pleasant. Lat 46.46.58.5 Lat by D R 46.58.5

on board the Ship Shaw Perkins Saml. Broad. Master on these 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from N.W. attended with snow. The same at 2 P.M. the wind hauled to the E. N.E. with thick snow: jibed ship and set the jib, latter parts cloudy at 3 A.M. set the square-sail and took in the main-sail, ends cloudy. No Ck this day.

Sunday October 2nd These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from N.W. and cloudy weather, at 5 P.M. took in the main-sail, Middle parts squally weather, latter parts light breezes from N.W. attended with thick snow, ends light breezes from S.E. with hail. No Ck this day.

Monday October 3rd These 24 hours commences with light airs and variable weather, Middle parts light breezes from N.W. and cloudy, at 2 P.M. set the square-sail, latter parts moderate breezes and clear at 4 P.M. set the main-sail, at 7 jibed ship, ends fresh breezes from N.W. Lat 46.48.51.5.

Tuesday October 4th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from N.W. attended with snow squalls, at 5 P.M. took in the main-sail, and set the key-sail, Middle parts the same, latter parts more moderate with pleasant weather, at 8 A.M. set the main-sail reefed, ends the same. Lat 46.48.38.5.

Wednesday October 5th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from N.W. and pleasant weather, at 5 P.M. made the land the west part of Cloudy Island, bearing per compass S.E. by S. distant 5 leagues, Middle parts light breezes from N.W. running in for the land at 1 A.M. run in to Mussel Bay, and run her a little latter parts strong breezes from west, with thick snow squalls, ends these 24 hours.

Thursday October 6th Ship Shaw Perkins lying in Mussel Bay Desolation October 6th 1842 These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from west, with thick snow squalls, Middle parts the same, latter parts light snow squalls at 8 A.M. went on shore a muskelling ends moderate.

Friday October 7th These 24 hours commences with light breezes with snow squalls, Middle parts moderate and pleasant went on shore and got off three boat loads of ballast, at meridian got under way in Mussel Bay and run down to Carrials Cove, latter parts light breezes from west and pleasant weather, at 4 P.M. came to in Carrials Cove, ends with rain.

Saturday October 8th These 24 hours commences with light squally weather, Middle parts light breezes from west and clear, at 7 A.M. went on shore a took three elephants, latter parts fresh breezes from north at 1 P.M. got under way and run down the coast, at 4 P.M. came to in Little Harbor, ends fresh squalls from N.W.

Sunday October 9th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from N.W. and squally, Middle parts pleasant all hand on shore, employed in digging birds and hunting grub, latter parts moderate weather.

Monday October 10th These 24 hours commences with light breezes from west and clear, Middle parts moderate employed in ship's duty, latter parts fresh breezes from N.E. with rain, laying in Little Harbor.

Tuesday October 11th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from N.E. with rain, Middle parts fine pleasant weather, went on shore to dig birds, and took for elephant, found one on half moon beach, latter parts rainy weather.

Wednesday October 12th These 24 hours commences with light breezes from north and rainy weather, Middle parts squally latter parts the same, ends fresh squalls from N.W. laying in Little Harbor.
