

These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from N.W. and pleasant weather, at 1 P.M. got under way down the coast, looking for the ship and schooner, at half past 2 A.M. came to in Margins Bay, the wind N.E. Latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. with pleasant weather.

Thursday
October 15th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from N.W. and pleasant weather, Middle parts thick snow squalls. Latter parts light breezes, and pleasant weather, ends equally laying in Margins Bay.

Sunday
October 18th These 24 hours commences with light breezes from north, and rainy, at 9 A.M. went on shore, and got off a cask of water, at 4 got under way, bound down the coast, at half past 6 P.M. came to in Skeal water Bay, ends pleasant the wind N.W.

Monday
October 19th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from W.S.W. attended with snow squalls, Middle parts the same. Latter parts more moderate, ends pleasant the wind west.

Tuesday
October 20th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from north, at 8 A.M. got under way in Skeal water bay, and went round to Three Island harbor, at 1 P.M. came to, and found the Bark Mariah of Rio Janeiro Capt Whippley. Latter parts fresh gales with rain.

Wednesday
October 21th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from north, and rainy, Middle parts the same, Latter parts more moderate landed the spare spars and took of a boat load of ballast, ends pleasant.

Thursday
October 22th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from west and pleasant weather, employed in baiting out and taken in ballast, Latter parts fresh squalls of wind and snow, ends the same laying in Three Island Harbor, Desolation.

Friday
October 23th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from north, attended with moderate rain, Middle and Latter parts the same, ends fresh breezes from S.W. with squalls of snow.

Saturday
October 24th These 24 hours commences with light breezes from N.W. and pleasant, at half past 5 A.M. got under way in Three Island harbor, ran close to mutton cove, and took in three casks of water, and unbent the jib and bent another, at half past 11 A.M. got under way bound up the coast, at half past 3 P.M. came to in Skeal water bay, so ends this day.

Sunday
October 25th These 24 hours commences with light breezes from N.W. and pleasant weather, at 3 A.M. got under way from Skeal water bay, bound up the coast, at 10 o'clock the main sail, at half past 9 came to in royal bay, blowing fresh, ends the same.

Monday
October 26th These 24 hours commences with fresh gales from north and squally weather. Middle parts more moderate, at 9 A.M. got under way from royal bay, bound up the coast, the wind N.W. at 11 fresh gales squared away and reefed the main sail, at meridian let go the anchor in royal bay. Latter parts more moderate, ends light breezes from N.W.

Tuesday
October 27th These 24 hours commences light breezes from N.W. and pleasant weather, at 9 A.M. got under way bound up the coast, to look for the ship and schooner, at meridian fell in with the schooner, and squared away and ran in to port harbor, in company with her, at 1 P.M. came to, ends pleasant weather the wind N.W.

Thursday
October 27th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from north, and rainy, at 3 A.M. got under way, at 10 o'clock the head reef, at 1 P.M. came to in little harbor, Latter parts fresh breezes with snow, so ends this day the wind S.S.W.

Friday
October 28th These 24 hours commences with light airs from W.S.W. and pleasant weather, at 9 A.M. went on shore to hunt provision, Middle and latter parts light breezes from N.W. laying in little harbor.

Saturday
October 29th These 24 hours commences with light breezes from W.N.W. and pleasant weather, at 9 A.M. got under way and stood out by Head Island, and sighted the islands to leeward, but saw no landing, went round the island, but saw nothing, at 3 P.M. came to in little harbor, with light breezes from north, went on shore and got off a cask of water, ends calm.

Sunday
October 30th These 24 hours commences with light airs from E.S.E. and thick foggy weather, Middle parts more calm, went on shore to hunt birds, Latter parts fine pleasant weather, so ends this day.

Monday
October 31st These 24 hours commences with light airs from S.E. and thick fog, Middle and latter parts the same, laying in little harbor, waiting for the ship.

Tuesday
November 1st These 24 hours commences with light breezes from N.W. and thick foggy weather, Middle and Latter parts pleasant, at 5 P.M. went on shore and killed an elephant, so ends this day.

Wednesday
November 2nd These 24 hours commences with light breezes from west, and pleasant, Middle parts the same, Latter parts moderate squalls of snow, laying in little harbor.

Thursday
November 3rd These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from N.W. attended with snow and rain, at meridian got under way, bound down the coast, the wind N.W. by W. looking for the ship, at 3 P.M. came to in Margins bay, the wind W. by N. at 5 went on shore, took off eggs and muskats, so ends this day.

Friday
November 4th At 5 A.M. got under way, with fresh breezes from N.W. and thick snow squalls, at 8 o'clock the head reef, set the main sail, at 11 A.M. passed Cape Digh, the wind north, at 1 P.M. saw the schooner standing across Skeal water bay, at 2 o'clock her and found the ship had not arrived, at half past 2 we both came to in Skeal water bay, the wind N.W. so ends this day.

Saturday
November 5th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from N.W. and pleasant weather, Middle and Latter parts the same, ends light breezes from N.W. laying in Skeal water bay.

Sunday
November 6th These 24 hours commences with light breezes from north, and pleasant weather, at 9 A.M. the schooner got under way bound to Table Bay, at half past 11 A.M. we got under way bound up the coast, to look for the ship, the wind west, Latter part the same.

Monday
November 7th These 24 hours commences with light breezes from north and cloudy weather, at half past 5 A.M. found the ship laying in little harbor, arrived the day before, Middle and Latter parts thick snow squalls, so ends these 24 hours.
