These 24 hours light breezes and pleasant
weather men employed in duties of the ship

All this day light breeze and pleasant weather
steering East men employed in duties of the ship

Saturday Aug 12th
Fine breezes and pleasant weather men
employed in duties of the ship

Sunday Aug 13th
Light breeze from N W and pleasant weather
steering E by S

Lat 38-53 Long 25-28

Monday Aug 14th
Begins with light breeze from the Northward
and calm weather one sail in sight middle and
last part much light and huffing leading
S S E Variation 1 1/4 Points Westerly

Lat 38-10 Long 24-28

Bound to the Western Islands

Tuesday August 13th 1848

Begins with light breeze from the Eastward and
huffing saw a steam vessel steering to the Northward
Still saw a larger ship to windward heading the same
way saw a school of blackfish "barn" got
fast to me and drove

Lat 37-38 Long 23-9

Wednesday Aug 14th
Begins with light breeze from N E and calm weather
saw blackfish "barn" did not get fast two sails
in sight middle light breeze and huffing last part
calm

Lat 37-30 Long 21-49

Thursday Aug 15th
Begins with calm weather men employed in
duties of the ship last part light breezes from the
Westward two sails in sight

Lat 38-00 Long 19-38

Friday Aug 16th
Begins with light breezes from the Westward steering
E by S with all but last employed setting up rigging
When the night squalls with rain saw a Breeze
steering to the Southward latter part fine weather
saw a school of blackfish "barn" did not get
fast

Lat 37-37 Long 38-00

Saturday Aug 17th
Commenced with light breezes from the Northward
and pleasant weather steering E by S the rest part
of these 24 hours weather the same

Lat 38-23 Long 33-26
By Linner Clock 35-58

Sunday Aug 18th
These 24 hours light breeze and calm weather

Lat 38-29 Long 34-23

Monday Aug 19th
Light breeze and calm weather men employed in duties of
the ship
