

Barge Shepherds of Mystic

Tuesday August 24th Com with light breeze from the Southward steering E S E at 5 AM saw Hound bearing E N E by Cape Dist 30 miles
Lat 39° 10' Long 81° 00'

Wednesday Aug 25th Begins with light breeze from the Southward heading E S E saw gannets first one sail in sight 4 PM 6 in sight at twelve saw fogfall bearing S E distance 50 miles
Lat 39° 9' Long 80° 20'

Thursday Aug 26th Com with light breeze from the Southward middle and last part calm fogfall bearing South Dist 3 leagues
Shut Ends

Friday Aug 27th Begins with light baffling winds from S W W saw ship General Williams and Hicks at 6 PM fogfall bore West & five bore South Dist 4 miles then the night lay off and on in the passage at seven & 11 went on shore after the recruits while I was on shore they carried away the main top gallant fore taking ship
So Ends

Saturday Aug 28th Begins with fresh breeze from the Southward at 6 PM got every thing aboard went to sea my boatmen got in a fuss with the Portuguese and come near near getting killed Henry Howard came aboard drunk and crazy raising the Devil midall and latter light gales and smoky weather
Shut Ends

Sunday Aug 29th Begins with fresh breeze from the Southward saw fogfall bearing S E dist 5 miles took ship that to the westward spoke Capt Rice

Bound toward The Cap of Good Hope at 6 PM wind hauled to the westward were ship steering S S W latter part moderate breezes with drizzle employed felling a main top gallant fore Lat 38° 11' Long 80° 40'

Monday Aug 30th Begins with baffling winds from NW with heavy squalls and rain midall and last part light breeze and calm men employed in duties of the ship
37° 44' Lat 80° 20'

Tuesday Aug 31st Begins with light breeze from the Eastward towards night came on squally with tremendous heavy rains last part baffling winds and calm with tremendous sea on water spouts in sight occasionally
Lat 36° 12' Long 80° 45'

Wednesday Aug 31st Begins with baffling winds from S E with a heavy sea on bearing from the Northward middle and latter part light breeze and calm
Lat 35° 6' Long 80° 35'

Thursday Aug 31st First part calm weather last part strong breezes from E S E steering S S W employed felling the cutters gear
Lat 33° 9' Long 80° 41'

Friday September 1st Com with fresh breeze from E S E steering S S W with all sail set the rest part of the day weather the same
Lat 30° 48' Long 80° 30'

Saturday September 2nd All the day fresh breezes and pleasant weather steering S by W with all sail set
Lat 28° 28' 29'
