All this day light breeze and calm weather
Lat 39.39 Long 27.41

Monday Sept 4th

Begins with calm weather middle and latter
part light breeze from East and pleasant weather
employed fitting the boats Lat 26.06 Long 28.00

Tuesday Sept 5th

Begins with fresh breeze and clear weather
steering S by W thru the night breeze fresh with
a heavy sea on. Thus Ends Lat 20.39 Long 28.00

Wednesday Sept 6th

Calm with fresh breeze from East steering
S by W and ends the same noon
employed in duties of the ship Lat 21.16 Long 28.20

Thursday Sept 7th

All these 24 hours strong breeze from East
steering South with all sail set at 6 P.M.
saw a sail to windward at 8 A.M. was more
in sight we steering S by W with all sail set
Thus Ends Lat 18.38 Long 28.00

Friday Sept 8th

All this day strong breeze from N.E.
steering S by E with all sail set men
employed in duties of the ship
Lat 16.10 Long 27.35

Saturday Sept 9th

Begins with fresh breeze and squally
weather steering S.E. middle and latter part
calm with frequent rain squalls
Lat 14.44 Long 26.37

Sunday Sept 10th

Calm with calm weather attended with frequent rain
squally middle light breeze from S.W. steering
S by E latter part fresh breeze from South heading
S.E. by S one sail in sight to leeward heading the
same way Thus Ends The Day
Lat 13.46 Long 25.34

Monday Sept 11th

All these 24 hours baffling winds and squally weather
attended with rain two sails in sight saw one to
windward steering to the Northward
Thus Ends Lat 13.35 Long 24.37

Tuesday Sept 12th

Calm with light breeze from N.W. steering South middle
and latter part fresh breeze and squally attended
with rain Thus Ends Lat 10.35 Long 23.35

Wednesday Sept 13th

Begins with baffling winds from N.W. and squally
weather heading South and off to S.E. by S latter
part calm. Thus Ends Lat 9.32 Long 22.00

Thursday Sept 14th

Calm with calm weather middle and latter part light
breeze from W and N.W. saw a Bark bound
to the Northward Ends Lat 8.51 Long 21.35

Friday Sept 15th

Calm with variable winds and squally attended with
rain steering South latter part light breeze and
calm sent down for top gallant mast fitted
the rigging Thus Ends
Lat 7.22 Long 21.04

Saturday Sept 16th

Calm with calm weather at 6 P.M. a fresh breeze sprang
up from S.W. at twelve thus fresh and squally
double reef the topsails latter part weather
about the same saw no sail.
(Each remains sick with the venereal disease) Thus Ends Lat 6.40 Long 19.49
