Monday Sept 18th
All these 24 calm weather carpenter employed
calking the boards and putting on sheathing
Lat 6-11 Long 17-39
By Lunar Obs 17-35

Tuesday Sept 19th
Begins with calm weather middle and last part
light breeze from S W heading S by E one sail
in sight on the horizon This Ends
Lat 3-27 Long 17-32
By Lunar Obs 17-43

Wednesday Sept 20th
Came with light breezes from S W heading
S S E on sail in sight at dawn middle and
last part baffling winds with heavy rain squalls
Lat 4-31 Long 15-54

Thursday Sept 21st
Begins with the Trade one wind blowing
from all parts of the compass attended with
his fine rain squalls at 10 o'clock ship heading
West last part fresh breezes and pleasant weather two
barks heading to the eastward This Ends
variation 12 P West by
Lat 4-1 Long 16-54

Friday Sept 22nd
Came with fresh breezes from S by W heading
West men employed in duties of the ship 4 sails
in sight at 9 AM spoke Bark Portman of Richmond
Richmond from Liverpool last part light breeze
and pleasant weather 3 sail in sight
Lat 3-50 Long 18-48

Broad En A Halingvage

Saturday September 23rd
Came with head winds as usual and pleasant weather
heading West at 6 PM took ship heading S E last
part weather the same one barge in sight
This Ends Lat 3-21 Long 16-43

Sunday Sept 24th
Begins with strong breezes from S S W heading
S E with all sail set at 6 PM took ship heading
W by S last part fresh breezes and pleasant weather
four sail in sight Lat 2-40 Long 18-30

Monday Sept 25th
Begins with moderate breezes from the Southward
heading W by S at 6 PM saw Bark Portman of
Richmond last part light breeze and baffling
Saw a school of blackfish lower did not get far
This Ends
Lat 2-16 Long 18-51

Tuesday Sept 26th
Came with light breeze from the Southward and
baffling heading W by S W saw Bark James
Cott and Englishman took under how he
stood the same way four more sails in sight
last part light breeze and baffling men employed
taking down the rigging This Ends
Lat 2-55 Long 17-34

Wednesday Sept 27th
All these 24 hours light baffling winds from
the Southward saw a Dutch Barge of Liverpool
This Ends
Lat 0-55 Long 20-00

Thursday Sept 28th
All this day fresh breezes and pleasant weather
men employed taking down the rigging
This Ends
Lat 0-20 S Long 21-44
