Thursday Oct 13th

Begins with moderate breezes from E S E and pleasant weather heading S by W more southerly setting up rigging threw the night fresh breezes saw a sail standing in the Northward last part light breezes and pleasant weather

Thus Ends

Lat 25.20 Long 31.37

Friday Oct 13th

Begins with fresh breezes from East heading South above the night baffling winds and squally took in gallant sails reef the fore topsail last part moderate breezes and pleasant weather took in the two quarter boats put out the after one

Lat 26.36 Long 31.47

Saturday Oct 14th

Came with pleasant breezes from the Eastward heading S by E threw the night baffling winds and squally latter part pleasant saw finbacks

Lat 28.54 Long 30.50

Sunday Oct 15th

Begins with moderate breezes from N E with rain squally steering S E the rest part of the day pleasant weather

Lat 30.46 Long 28.35

Monday Oct 16th

All this day light breezes from the Northward and pleasant weather steering S E broke out between decks and down the tanks

Lat 31.49 Long 26.35

Tuesday Oct 17th

Came with light breezes from the Northward a heavy swell leaving up from the westward middle and last part light breezes from S E heading E N E

Lat 32.00 Long 23.23

Bound for Saint Peter Island

Wednesday Oct 13th

Came with light breezes from S E and foggy heading E N E middle and last part light breezes and foggy latter saw finbacks & porpoises

Lat 31.46 Long 25.00

Thursday Oct 19th

Begins with light breezes from the Eastward heading S S E saw number of finbacks middle and last part light breezes from North with foggy squalls

Lat 33.14 Long 25.20

Friday Oct 20th

Commences with light breezes from N E with foggy steering S E by S middle and last part pleasant breezes and cloudy saw finbacks and porpoises

Lat 34.34 Long 21.30

Saturday Oct 21st

Came with pleasant breezes from N E and cloudy steering S E by S with all sail set at 8 came on squally weather with rain took in studding sails middle and last part light breezes and thick fog

No Observation By Account

Lat 35.50 Long 21.15

Sunday Oct 22nd

Came with light breezes and thick foggy from the Eastward heading S S E middle and last part light gales and thick weather steering S E by E took in gallant sails reef the fore topsail

Thus Ends The Day

Lat 37.08 Long 17.17

Monday Oct 23rd

Begins with light gales from North attended with rain steering E S E under topsails and courses at 8 blow fresh with rain Double reef the topsails at 11 weather more moderate made all sail at twelve blow on fresh with heavy squalls and rain took in gallant sails Double reef the topsails heading E by S under N N E saw thousands of white whale breasts but no whales

So Ends with thick weather
