Tuesday Oct 24th

Came with gales from the Northward with foggy
and rain saw number of finbacks at 8 hours
on heavy with foggy and rain kept off S by S
to clear Frestone Island at 5 PM hauled
up E S E wind N E last part blow fresh
thunder with foggy squalls This Ends

Lat 37° 55' Long 12° 5'

Wednesday Oct 25th

Begins with gales from N E heading E S E at 3 PM
Sightings of Island by sighting bar N W dist 30 miles
middle and last part fresh gales and thick weather

This Ends bar N W

Lat 38° 08' Long 9° 44'

Thursday Oct 26th

Came with fresh gales from N E steering S by E
under Double reef Tophits & covered saw a
school of white whale porpoises middle sailing
last part light gales and pleasant saw plenty
of finbacks & thousands of white whale birds

This Ends The Day

Lat 38° 23' Long 7° 1'

Friday Oct 27th

Commences with fine gales from the Northward & pleasant
weather steering E S E with all sail set bent a new
main spruce saw finbacks and whale birds
middle and last part moderate breezes and thick foggy

This Ends No Clear by account

Lat 38° 31' Long 4° 00'

Saturday Oct 28th

Begins with light breezes from N N E with thick foggy
steering E S E latter part light breezes from N E
& pleasant weather heading S E saw Merchant barge
steering S E

This Ends

Lat 38° 56' Long 1° 27'

Bound for St. Paul Island

Sunday Oct 29th

Commences with moderate breezes from N E & pleasant weather
heading S E saw number of finbacks thru the night
wind North steering East at 8 AM saw two right whale
going quick to windward lower did not get fast
saw number of finbacks This Ends The Day

Lat 38° 33' Long 1° 21' East

Monday Oct 30th

Came with pleasant breezes from the Northward steering
East saw finbacks at 4 PM saw a ship to windward steering
S E threw the night winds light and huffing at 11 AM
saw one right whale lower did not get fast last part
light breezes from S E with foggy This Ends

Lat 37° 45' Long 3° 23' East

Tuesday Oct 31st

Came with small winds from S E heading E N E middle
calm & rainy at 4 PM fresh breezes from N W steering S by E
lat Huddling sails aloft & aloft saw two ships steering the
same way

This Ends Variation 2 P M steady

Lat 37° 37' Long 5° 42'

Wednesday November 1st

Commences with pleasant gales from N W steering S E by E
with all sail set at 7 PM a merchant ship by the
name of Christian passed to windward took her to be a
Prussian by her rig at twelve hours fresh with foggy look
in gallantstudding sails & low Huddling sail at 2 AM &
darker let the ship back to carried away foretopmast
studding sail boom at 6 AM wing hauled S W in a rain squall
look in gallantstudding Double reefed topmast last part fresh
gales and clear weather

This Ends Variation 2 P M steady

Lat 37° 40' Long 9° 30'

Thursday Nov 2nd

Begins with fresh gales from S W & clear weather steering
S E by E threw the night winds huffing with a heavy sea
heaving from the westward last part light winds and calm
saw finbacks
