Came with pleasant breezes from West steering E S E with all sail set middle & last part light and calm

Saturday Nov 25th

Came with calm weather middle and last part fresh breezes from West with pleasant weather fair fimbals

Sunday Nov 26th

Came with pleasant gales from West steering E by S with all sail set threw the night squally with a rough sea on took in gullants last part moderate breezes and pleasant weather

Begins with light breezes from West steering E S E with all sail set threw the night calm last part light breezes from the Northward This Ends
Lat 36-30 Long 74-00

Tuesday Nov 28th

Begins with light breezes from the Northward steering S E by E at 3 P.M. saw two right whale breved mate got fast & run away with him held on till night came back in sail have to on the wind number were unable in sight took them to be right whale At 11 saw nothing left off on a course steering S E by E last part clear gales & pleasant

Wednesday Nov 22th

Came with clear gales from N W pleasant weather steering S E with all sail set for Antedrom Island at 4 P.M. by resting here S E by E in E Distance 124 miles threw the night Breeze fresh with thick weather at 8 A.M. Breeze being low nothing of the land appeared we run by it took in all sail have to last part Breeze tremendous heavy

Thursday Nov 30th

Came with heavy gales from N W ship heading up N E by E at 8 P.M. wire hauls N S W in a heavy rain squall seas baking over all parts of her wheel got away from one of the men stove it at 3 A.M. cleared off blowing fresh from N S W saw Antedrom Island bearing N W 1/2 W Dist 15 miles set double reef topsails to work up to it split the job about it last weather at 12 land here N W gale increasing kept off for the East of New Zealand steering E S E from which I take my departure
