Saturday

Sunday March 24th

Begins with calm weather & good breeze when I shall have another fair wind it is ~~very~~ something that I haven't had for the last two months middle and last part - hazy wind and squally weather Thus Ends

Lat 10° 00' Long 151° 44'

Sunday

Saturday March 25th

First and last part fine breeze and pleasant weather heading N by W middle calm Thus Ends

Lat 10° 10' Long 151° 38'

Sunday March 26th

Begins with pleasant breeze from E. & E heading N by W with all but the rest part of these 24 hours weather the same Thus Ends

Lat 10° 11' Long 152° 20'

Tuesday March 27th

Come with fine breeze from E. & E heading N by W with all but last middle & last part strong breeze heading N by W Thus Ends

Lat 10° 31' Long 153° 16'

Wednesday March 28th

Come with strong breeze from N. E & cloudy weather heading N by W middle weather more moderate last part weather the same as the former Thus Ends

Lat 10° 16' Long 153° 35'

Thursday March 29th

Come with pleasant breeze from N. E. Steaming N by W by N at 12 saw Carthage bearing S by E 45 miles Chronometric in 23 days gained 55 miles by lunar observations Thus Ends

Bound to Home 1849

Tuesday March 30th

Commences with light breeze from East Steaming N by E at 6 P. M. hauls up N by E by W by N by E for Abowee bearing N by E 95 miles by lunar observations at 6 A. M. Abowee bore N by E 75 miles Carthage bearing S & E 80 miles Ends with fine weather

Saturday March 31st

Come with light breeze and pleasant weather running down with the land Steaming N by E at 8 got in to the mouth of the passage wind dropped off by 11 morning latter part calm saw three ships at anchor one went to sea Thus Ends

Sunday April 1st

Begins with light weather towards night light breeze at 8 came to anchor saw ship Whellerport bear N by E and Catharine of New London Ship Catharine went to sea got off 50 lbs potatoes & 10 lbs sweet and one pumpkin the Ensign

Monday April 2nd

Begins with calm weather at night got away King off ready for sea at 4 P. M. got underway with light wind off the land soon had away calm threw the light light breeze from the northward heading down between Morring and Ransom last part strong breeze from the northward at 12 hauled up both clock 15 miles Thus Ends

Tuesday April 3rd

Come with moderate breeze from the northward Steaming West the rest part of these 24 hours weather the same Thus Ends

Lat 10° 52' Long 157° 33'
