

Bark Shepherdess Arctic

Tuesday May 8th
Begins with light breeze from the Westward
Heading N. N. W. at 3 P.M. cleared up. Saw
Spanberg's Island bearing W. N. W. 11 miles
Chronometer by the land two degrees out of the
way middle land last part calm weather
Saw finbacks
Thus Ends M. Chase
By Acc Lat 45.00 Long 149.00

Wednesday May 9th
Begins with calm weather saw finbacks
Threw the night light buoys from the Eastward
Heading N. E. by N. N. W. wind hauled at 11 P.M. steering
East saw nothing
Thus Ends
Lat 45.00 Long 150.00
Chronometer 2 degrees out of the
way of the land

Thursday May 10th
Begins with light breeze from
N. W. steering N. E. at 3 P.M. saw one right
whale heard did not get fast at night carried
all sail saw finbacks and humpbacks last part
wind smooth
Thus Ends
Lat 45.00 Long 151.16

Friday May 11th
Came with light breeze from the Southward and pleasant
weather steering North saw finbacks bearing far North
Sea at 11 A.M. saw two right whale heard got fast
to one took him long time. Thus Ends
Lat 45.42 Long 151.50

Saturday May 12th
Begins with strong breeze from South with some
foggy weather ship cut the whale in to land at 3 P.M.
wind hauled out to the Northward blow heavy in squalls
I expected to have to let the whale go got him out
at 7 P.M. took in sail close reefed the main top sail
let her lay A.M. strong breeze from West started
the work let Double reefed. Steering N. N. W.
saw plenty of finbacks
Lat 45.00 Long 151.15

Bark for the Sea of Okhotsk

Sunday May 13th
Begins with fresh breeze from West steering N. W.
saw plenty of finbacks middle calm A.M. light breeze
saw 5 right whale heard went on to a pair of three in it
they settled saw plenty of finbacks Thus Ends
Lat 45.27 Long 151.22

Monday May 14th
Came with moderate breeze from West heading
N. N. W. middle calm A.M. light breeze from East
breeze in far the Okhotsk Sea steering N. N. W.
saw one ship to windward heading in shore saw
a sail to leeward heading off shore took it to
be Ship Kolshent of the U.S. at 8 A.M. saw the
land Royal Company Island bearing West Dist 20 miles
saw Komar or L'Anse Island Dist 15 miles last part
light breeze with lazy weather heading up N. E.
Thus Ends
Lat 46.33 Long by Chronometer 151.18

Tuesday May 15th
Begins with light breeze from East with some
foggy heading N. E. at 3 P.M. ship so thick
could not tell how the land bore took ship heading
S. E. Lat all sail standing of shore at 6 finbacks
baiting saw Komar Island bearing West Dist 11 miles
middle moderate breeze from East heading S. E. at 4 A.M.
took ship heading up with the land came on to
saw fresh took in gallant ship Double reefed the
top sails were ship heading S. E. at 11 weather more
moderate wave ship heading N. E. at all sail
Thus Ends
