Saturday June 9th

Begins with light breeze from the N.W. Steering N.
The Eastward to clear the ice at 6 P.M.
Spoke Ship Charles Phelps Huntington & whale
this season sailing at night with West heading North
at 3 A.M. Ship in among the ice made sail & had along
close to it till 8 o'clock A.M. saw nothing keep off steering
East & sail in sight Thus Ends
Lat 56-11 Long 150-28

Sunday June 10th

Begins with strong breezes from West steering
East saw fishbacks one sail in sight steering the
same way A.M. saw one small right whale but
did not get fast latter part light breeze and cloudy
weather one sail in sight Thus Ends N.C.
By Sec Lat 55-55 Long 153-00

Monday June 11th

Begins with light breezes from N.W. Steering N. saw one
right whale but did not get fast Spoke bark
Fellows Huntington 4 years out was the oil
Spoke Ship Splendid 600 Spring 2 months
out 1 whale at night double reef the topsails heading
N.W. A.M. saw nothing keep off N.E. Thus Ends
Lat 56-48 Long 152-47

Tuesday June 12th

Begins with light breezes from the Southward steering
East at 1 P.M. saw one right whale but did not
get fast saw another going quick to windward saw
two more going quick N.E. lower went on to them
and better middle and last saw calm saw nothing
and never expect to see whale again Thus Ends
Lat 57-10 Long 154-16

Wednesday June 13th

Begins with calm weather at 4 P.M. light breeze from
N.W. steering E by S at night double reef the topsails
saw nothing last part light breezes from S.W. steering
East saw one humpback at 12 saw the land bearing
East Dist 20 miles Thus Ends N.C.
Lat 57-14 Long by Sec 156-35

Thursday June 14th

Begins with light breezes from S.W. steering N. to
the land sent the boats in shore fishing but caught
nothing landed on one of the small Islands saw 9 seals
stationed there for seal all the better they had was
a chance at night caught all sail hauled to the west
saw one 8 miles from the land 14 fathoms water
last part light breezes from the Southward heading N.W. by S
saw Ship Splendid 600 Spring heading to the Eastward
the bark Ship there the same way Thus Ends
N.C. Lat 57-54 Long By Sec 157-02

Friday June 15th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Southward steering N.W. by S
towards night set in rainy threw the night fresh gale from
S.E. attended with rain last part moderate weather saw number
of small right whale all going quick to the Southward
but with no success Thus Ends N.C.
By Sec Lat 57-40 Long 158-10

Saturday June 16th

Begins with light breezes from the Southward steering to the
westward saw three small right whale going quick to
the Southward but for one did not get fast threw
the night light breezes from the Eastward steering N.W. by S
6 ships in sight at 5 A.M. Spoke Ship Governor Pease
New Bedford no whale Thus Ends N.C.
By Sec Lat 57-30 Long 151-
