shut in sight too boiling saw one right whale
broke did not get fast made all sail steering
N.W. All saw number of right whale going
quick bore did not get fast 4 ships in sight
whaling at 11 saw one sheephead bore
took him long side plenty more in sight

Tuesday June 26th

Begins with fresh breezes and pleasant weather
saw the whale in plenty more in sight saw two
lost to the ship bore did not get fast saw one
ship cutting All strong breezes from the South
four ships in sight whaling and boiling

a rough sea at 5 P.M. saw a sheephead a ship

at 9 A.M. let the fire go out commenced
cutting last part rugged rugged weather
wind from S.W. cut the whale to board
