Calm with light airs from S.W. fair sails in sight three the night wind from East and S.E. last part light airs from S.E. and pleasant weather & sails in sight

All these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather heading South and S.W. all hands employed bunking down and sail in sight

Lat 27-03 Long 153-20

Saturday Oct 27th

Begins with pleasant breezes from E.S.E. heading South all hands employed taking care of her last part winds East steering S.E. finished the home tried it below

Lat 25-10 Long 153-40

Sunday Oct 28th

All these 24 hours fine breezes and pleasant weather steering E.S.E.

All these 24 hours fresh breezes and squally weather steering S.W.

Lat 24-17 Long 153-40

Tuesday Oct 30th

Begins with strong breezes and squally weather steering S.W. at 10 AM saw Mowee East End bearing N.W. 40° Dist 11 miles at 10 AM came to anchor so sheeps luffing

Begins with light airs and baffling. Sound to Parakokoa Bay last part fresh gales and clear weather

Fresh gales and clear weather steering S.E. with Starboard watch three on liberty last part calm Parakokoa Bay bearing East N. South Dist 20 miles
