Came with fresh breezes from S.E. Cruising under
sky two sails in sight middle and last part calm
men employed in duties of the ship
Thus Ends

Sunday Dec 30th
Came with calm weather saw porpoises two sails in
sight middle and last part calm
Thus Ends

Monday Dec 31st
Began with calm weather saw a school blackfish
bored got two the rest part of them 24 found with the
same saw two huggs steering to the northward
Thus Ends

Tuesday January 1st 1850
Came with light breeze from West N.W. spoke
hugg James Hill 60 Tons from Sydney
Bound to California last part fresh breezes from N.W.
in company with the hugg James Hill
Thus Ends

Wednesday Jan 2nd
Came with fresh breezes from N.W. cruising in to the
land middle and last part light breezes from the
Northward stove up our old boat to replace an other
Thus Ends

Thursday January 3rd
Came with light breeze from North heading to the southward
last part weather the same Carpenter employed repairing
an old boat
