Friday January 4th
Begins with calm weather & breeze bearing N^W & Dist 20 miles the rest part of these 25 hours calm as usual
Thus Ends

Saturday Jan 5th
Calm with calm weather attended with rain last part light gales from East attended with rain ~~that~~ but Double reef topsails leading in towards the land
Thus Ends as before

Sunday Jan 6th
Begins with strong breezes from E & leading N^E at 6 P.M. were ship stood off shore then the light light winds with heavy rain last part light and from N^W and pleasant weather Thus Ends
Lat 15.12 Long 157.26

Monday Jan 7th
Begins with light breeze from N^W and pleasant weather then the light calm last part light breeze from N^W leading N^E & breeze bearing N^E & Dist 40 miles
Thus Ends
Lat 15.20 Long 157.00

Tuesday Jan 8th
Calm with light breeze from N^W leading N^E & employed repairing sails Carpenter employed repairing and old boat last part calm & breeze bearing N^E & Dist 25 miles
Lat 16.00 Long

Wednesday Jan 9th
Begins with calm weather repaired the foremast bent it again then the night light was from the Eastward last part calm employed repairing a mainmast Ends

Thursday Jan 10th
Calm with calm weather employed repairing sails & breeze bearing East Dist 40 miles middle fresh gales from N^W & E off run under the lead of
Thus Ends

Cruising off Colbye

Friday January 11th 1850
Calm with fresh breezes from the Northward and cloudy weather at 6 P.M. Double reefed the topsails & breeze from fresh with heavy squally middle weather more moderate made sail took us towards shore at 8 P.M. saw humpbacks took them to be sperm whale sound did not get fast
Thus Ends

Saturday Jan 12th
Begins with fine weather at night fresh breezes and squally Double reefed the topsails leading in for evening last part fine weather Cooper employed taking up sheets
Thus Ends

Sunday Jan 13th
Begins with fine weather stood in sight of the anchorage at 10 AM saw no shipping stood out to the Southward again at night heavy rain and squally last part light breezes with sun rain Rainy bearing N^W & Dist 18 miles
Thus Ends

Monday Jan 14th
Calm with light breezes from N^E with sun rain leading to the Northward and Eastward then the night strong winds last part light breezes from East Rainy bearing N^W & Dist 5 miles
Thus Ends

Tuesday Jan 15th
Calm with baffling winds and rainy weather then the night light breeze off the land last part calm and rainy then two ships at anchor in harbor saw a hump bearing to the Northward then the passing
Thus Ends

Wednesday Jan 16th
Begins with calm weather and plenty of rain middle weather the same last part light breeze from North and cloudy Cooper employed taking up sheets
Thus Ends
