Came with fresh gales from the Northward heading N.W. & W. middle and last part moderate gales with a rough sea steering W by N with double reef topmasts set

Commenced with light gales from the Northward with a rough sea steering W by N with double reef topmasts set at 4.30 spoke ship Nathaniel P. Salmons at 8.00 went aboard

Came with breezes from the Eastward steering N.W. in company with ship Nathaniel P. Salmons at night shortened sail wind S.E. attended with rain steering N.W. last part light breezes & fine weather in company with ship Nathaniel P. Salmons saw finbacks and porpoises

Came with light breezes from S.E. steering N.W. at night shortened sail thru the night light breezes with rain last part pleasant breezes from the Northward saw finbacks and porpoises

Came with pleasant breezes from N.W. & heading N.W. in company with ship Nathaniel P. Salmons late afternoon saw porpoises caught five middle and last part wind light & gentle saw a right whale going quick west
