Wednesday June 19th

Begins with moderate breezes from South heading East S E at 6 p.m. spoke Ship Enterprise New Bedford & whale went about westward heading to the westward in company bound in to the sea of another middle fresh gales with fog and rain Doubtless reef the topsails take in jib and main sail but part weather about the same a heavy sea on board in foretopmast

Thursday June 20th

Begins fresh gales from South heading W by S a rough sea and thick fog middle gale abated at 10 A.M. saw plenty of pale whale bones took one long side so rough had to let him lay long side three ships in sight about dawn Thus Ends No Obs
By Sea Lat 64.20 Long 176.30

Friday June 21st

Came with fresh breezes from S W heading up S E plenty of whale in sight at 8 A.M. down on a heavy gale from S W found 50 fathoms of water and let the whale go to the Deavils but Doubtless reefed to work off shore Thus Ends No Obs

Saturday June 22nd

Begins with fresh gales from S W very hot to keep off shore spoke Ship Enterprise New Bedford saw whale bones did not get fast Thus Ends

Cruising for whale in sea Ancker

Sunday June 23

Came with light breeze from S W the sun clear 20 miles but not calm saw whale going quiet S W 14 ships in sight Thus Ends
Lat 64.00 Long 176.00

Monday June 24th

Begins with calm weather spoke Bark Columbia Shephard's whale spoke Ship Henry & Co. saw but part calm 24 ships in sight Thus Ends
Lat 63.40 Long 176.15

Tuesday June 25th

Begins with calm weather saw thousands of whale going S W found got fast to one took him long side at 1 about 10 A.M. him 12 miles out the whale in started the work saw three ships cutting saw whale bones so wide did not get near them Thus Ends
Lat 63.29 Long 176.60

Wednesday June 26th

Came with light breeze from West and pleasant weather last part calm 23 ships in sight saw ship bringing hauling saw plenty of whale so wide could not get fast Thus Ends The Day
Lat 63.21 Long 176.80

Thursday June 27th

Begins with calm weather saw plenty of whale found got one took him long side and him in last part had a heavy thunder storm Thus Ends
Lat 63.16 Long 176.45
