Begins with calm weather and foggy at night light breeze from South then the night heavy rain last part strong breezes attended with thick fog last a clear fair top gallant sail

Came with strong breezes from South attended with thick fog heading E by S last part weather the same

Friday July 26th

Begins with fresh breezes from South attended with thick fog heading E by S at night wind S W steering S E by E last part light breezes and thick fog set making sails

Begins with light breezes from S W attended with thick fog steering S E by E then the night heavy rain last part clear up sun wind hale S W
