Wednesday Aug 7th

Begins with strong winds from E. S. E. heading S. E. with single reef topsails set at 4 P. M. set Main top gallant sail middle heavy squalls with rain soft. the topsail at 8 P. M. tacked ship heading to the Northward had wind and rain expect to get a fair wind till it get to the Northward

Thursday Aug 8th

Begins with light gales from E. N. E. and squalls heading North last part light air from N. E. by E. heading S. E. by E.
Thus Ends
Lat 33° 05' Long 160° 45'

Friday Aug 9th

Came with light air from N. E. heading E. S. E. with all sail set men employed taking up the sheathing at night light air from East sailed ship heading N. N. E. last part baffling winds and calm
Lat 33° 09' Long 160° 23'

Saturday Aug 10th

Begins with light breeze winds and more expect a fair heading North with all sail set last part light air and calm
Thus Ends
Lat 34° 30' Long 163° 11'

Sunday Aug 11th

Begins with light air from the Eastward and pleasant weather middle and last part light breeze from S. E. heading E. S. E.
Thus Ends
Lat 35° 00' Long 162° 20'

Monday Aug 12th

Came with light breeze from S. E. heading E. S. E. with all sail set last part light air variable
Thus Ends
Lat 35° 55' Long 160° 22'
By Sun at 160° 00'

Tuesday Aug 13th

Came with small winds from the Eastward at 4 P. M. tacked ship heading to the Northward last part baffling winds and rainsqualls
Thus Ends
Lat 35° 40' Long 159° 30'

Wednesday August 14th

Begins with calm weather and raining at night cleared off light breeze from East heading S. E. last part light air from E. N. E. heading S. E. employed calking the ship topsails
Thus Ends
Lat 35° 06' Long 160° 09'
By Sun at 160° 00'

Thursday Aug 15th

Came with light air from E. N. E. and pleasant weather heading S. E. employed calking the ship topsails last part winds variable and squally
Thus Ends
Lat 34° 15' Long 159° 25'

Friday Aug 16th

Begins with variable winds from N. E. steering S. E. employed calking ship thro' the night squally last part light breeze and pleasant weather
Thus Ends
Lat 35° 04' Long 158° 25'
