All this day light variable winds from East
Thru Ends
Lat 30.8 Long 157.37

Monday Aug 19th

All this day light variable winds from East men
employed duties of the ship. Thru Ends
Lat 29.32 Long 157.20

Tuesday Aug 20th

Began with light breeze and squally at 4 P.M. spoke
the Barge steering to the northward thru the
night of fresh breeze steering S. E. by S last
part wind light and baffling. Thru Ends
Lat 28.12 Long 156.30

Wednesday Aug 21st

Began with light breeze from East
steering S. E. then a ship to windward
steering the same way thru the night squally
last part light and pleasant but not
pleasant weather. Thru Ends
Lat 26.45 Long 156.30

Came with light breeze from East and pleasant
weather steering S. E. with all sail set
thru the night squally last part light wind
and baffling. Thru Ends
Lat 25.4 Long 156.30

Friday August 23rd

Began with light winds from East and baffling

last. Thru Ends
Lat 23.54 Long 156.47

Saturday Aug 24th

Began with strong winds from East
and squally weather steering S. E. by E
at 4 P.M. spoke by account bars South East
140 miles variation, Point East at 6 A.M.
saw the West End of Moore being South East
40 miles last part strong breeze and
pleasant weather. Thru Ends

Sunday Aug 25th

Came with fresh winds and pleasant weather
at 4 P.M. spoke to make ship off E. by
Newell's home in full last part
fine clear weather steering S. E. and
on liberty. Thru Ends

Monday Aug 26th

All this day fine weather but had water
on liberty carpenter employed caulking the ship.
