All this day fine weather got every thing aboard ready
for sea Thus Ends

Thursday Sept 5th

Calm with pleasant weather at 2 P.M. got underway
and went to sea but had moderate breeze and pleasant
weather
Lat 14° 30' Long 156° 38'

Friday Sept 6th

Calm with pleasant weather middle and last part calm
Lat 15° 43' Long 157° 00'

Saturday Sept 7th

Begins with light breeze from E. S. E. heading
South middle part breeze true squally last
part weather dark dirty and raining Thus Ends
No. 6 bar by sea Lat 17° 40' Long 157° 00'

Sunday Sept 8th

Begins with moderate breeze from East weather
dark and raining heading S. S. E. middle part breeze
with heavy squalls last part variable weather with
frequent rain squalls
Thus Ends
Lat 15° 30' Long 156° 50'

Monday Sept 9th

Begins with light gale and squally weather
windy from E. S. E. heading S. S. E. last part fine clear
weather with a north sea
Thus Ends
Lat 15° 44' Long 157° 24'
