

Barque Shepherds Arctic

Friday Oct 4th

Came with strong gales from East with a rough sea and clear weather middle and last part weather more moderate still a heavy sea keeps up set Double reef topsails jib and mainsail

Thus Ends

Lat 14° 10' Long 166° 22'

Saturday Oct 5th

Commenced with strong winds from East with a rough sea steering South with Double reef topsails set at night blew on fresh tide in jib blew with the foretopsail last part weather more moderate ends

Lat 15° 46' Long 167° 12'

Sunday Oct 6th

All these 24 hours light gales from East and pleasant weather

Thus Ends

Lat 17° 27' Long 167° 17'

Monday Oct 7th

Commenced with pleasant breezes from East heading S by E with all sail set threw the night squally last part pleasant weather sent down the maintopsail yard found it sprung fixed it and sent it up

Lat 19° 11' Long 167° 20'

Tuesday Oct 8th

Begins with fresh breezes from East heading S by E employing fishing the main topsail yard middle squally with ship at 10 to clear an island and reefs at 2 o'clock took ship heading S by E finished the topsail rigging sent it aloft sent a new Abain topsail

Thus Ends

Lat 20° 02' Long 167° 09'

Bound. Towards Ca. Haven

Wednesday Oct 9th

Begins with light gales from N E and pleasant weather steering S by E with all sail set at 10 wind hauled to North last part fresh gales from N W and cloudy

Thus Ends

Lat 22° 50' Long 166° 01'

Thursday Oct 10th

Came with fresh gales from N W with dark dirty weather steering S by E at 4 P.M. wind hauled to N W in a heavy rain squall threw the night fresh gales with a rough sea steering E by S W with Double reef topsails set last part fresh breezes and pleasant weather employed setting up rigging

Thus Ends

Lat 23° 30' Long 165° 15'

Friday Oct 11

Begins with fresh breezes from S S W steering E S E with all sail set middle and last part weather the same sent down the foretopsail yard condemned it sent up a new one

Thus Ends

Lat 24° 41' Long 165° 50'

Saturday Oct 12

Came with light breezes from S W with a heavy swell on steering E S E middle calm last part fresh breezes from South ship heaving had found the deck slant to the stem under bar view plank rotten and seams all rotted out calked it as well as I could and battened over it first time that I ever was caught in an all reef like this and hope it will be the last
