Come with light breezes from SSE heading East with  
all sail set at night when middle light breeze from  
East heading S by E last part wind the same

Thus Ends The Day

By Lunar Observation 157-44

First part of these 24 hours calm weather  
last part light breeze from East heading E by S

Thus Ends  
Lat 26-00 Long 157-10

Wednesday Oct 16

Begins with moderate breezes from East heading S by E  
with all sail set middle squally wind from East E  
heading S by S last part light breeze from East and  
pleasant

Thus Ends  
Lat 27-26 Long 156-48

Thursday Oct 17

Come with light breeze from East heading E by E with  
all sail set when the main gallant sail set a  
few more middle and last part strong breeze from ESE and  
cloudy

Thus Ends  
Lat 29-22 Long 157-20

Friday Oct 18

Begins with fresh breeze from East with some rain middle  
and last part light gales and cloudy weather

Thus Ends The Day  
Lat 31-23 Long 157-10

Bound Towards Cape Horn

Saturday Oct 19

Begins with light gales from East heading SSE  
with Double reef topsails set last part light breeze and fine  
weather men employed in duties of the ship Thus Ends

Lat 32-55 Long 157-30

Sunday Oct 20

Come with light breeze from ESE heading South with all  
sail set employed setting up rigging middle and last  
part calm

Thus Ends  
Lat 33-40 Long 157-00

Monday Oct 21

Begins with light breeze from the Northward steering S by E  
middle and last part strong breezes and squally wind  
in steering sails and top gallant sails took in the anchors  
steered them when the crew were thus Ends

Lat 35-5 Long 155-25

Tuesday Oct 22

Come with light gales from the Northward steering  
S by E middle fresh gales with rain took in gallant sails  
Double reef the topsails at 4 o'clock wind hauled  
S off in a heavy squall last part light breezes  
and pleasant weather a rough sea on Thus Ends

Lat 36-45 Long 153-50

Wednesday

Thursday Oct 23

Begins with light breezes from S W steering E S E  
with all sail set last part calm Thus Ends

Lat 37-45 Long 152-00

Friday Oct 24

Come with light breeze from S E heading E S E a heavy swell  
bearing from the westward middle and last part calm

Thus Ends The Day  
Lat 38-10 Long 151-40

Saturday Oct 25

Come with light breeze from the Northward steering East a heavy swell bearing from  
the westward men employed repairing sails middle watch rain hauled  
to the westward last part light breeze from S W and pleasant  
weather Thus Ends
