Came with light gales from N. W. with thick rain weather steering East with topsails set at 8 gale increasing double reef the topsails took in jib and mainmast last part strong gales and thick rainy weather close reef the topsails Thus Ends No. 12

Wednesday Nov 13

Begins with fresh gales from N. W. with thick weather steering East with close reef topsails set middle weather more moderate last part heavy gales with a high sea and plenty of rain Thus Ends No. 13

Came with heavy gales from N. W. with a high sea attended with plain of rain steering E by S with close reef topsails set at night cleared off wind hauled West blows on tremendous heavy in squalls at 12

hauled all hands for to see the barbare took under a mainmast last part gales from S. W. with tremendous squalls with a high sea running Thus Ends No. 14

Begins with heavy gales from S. W. with a high sea and frequent late squalls took off much close reef topsails and fresh sea heaving over all parts of the middle and last part fresh gales with high sea Thus Ends No. 15
