Saturday Nov 16

Came with fresh gales and foggy squalls wind West steering E by South with Double reef topsails set at 4 PM turned the reef out the mainmast set main gallant sail the rest part of these 24 hours weather the same

Thus Ends The Day

Sunday Nov 17

Began with fresh gales from West and squally steering E by S with Double reef topsails set while weather the same last part wind hauled to the starboard side after haul back at 1 PM blow on fresh with fresh rainy weather sent lower main reefal spar

Monday Nov 18

Began with heavy gales from S W with rain steering E by S with Double reef topsails set mercury in the barometer standing very low at 6 PM wind hauled S W in a tremendous squall close reef the fore topsail threw the night close gales with frequent squalls last part heavy gales from W S W backing under close reef topsails

Thus Ends The Day
By Acc Lat 54° 01' Long 85° 50'

Tuesday Nov 19

Began with heavy gales from W S W with a high thick weather running under close reef topsails at 1 P.M. hauled to under main sails at 10 wind hauled S W in a tremendous squall at 12 hours a luminous barometer standing 29 inches at 6 PM gale abated set topsails standing reef last part fresh gales and high sea

Thus Ends The Day
Lat 54° 28' Long 82° 50'

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Wednesday Nov 20

Began with fresh gales from West and heavy weather and high sea steering E by S with double reef topsails set middle weather about the same at 2 PM wind hauled S W in a heavy squall close reef the topsails latter part moderate gales with frequent light squalls made all sail

Thus Ends The Day
Lat 55° 30' Long 79° 50'

Thursday Nov 21

Came with moderate gales from West with a rough sea and clear weather steering E by S with gallant sails set at night weather dark and heavy saw a large ship's head in the distance midnight weather the same last part backing wind and rain set sliding sails

Thus Ends The Day
Lat 56° 41' Long 76° 30'

Friday Nov 22

Began with backing winds from West and rain at 2 PM wind hauled S W back in sliding sails middle and last part pleasant gales from West and S W steering E by S with all sail set

Thus Ends The Day
Lat 57° 12' Long 71° 30'

Barometer 29 1/2 points Easting

Saturday Nov 23

Came with pleasant gales from S W steering E by S by compass with all sail set at night came on squally tack in sliding sails Double reef the topsails middle and last part strong gales from North and S W with a smooth sea and plenty of rain passing 7 ships these 24 hours all bound to the Westward

By Acc Lat 57° 11' Long 66° 00'

Barometer 29 points East

Sunday Nov 24

Came with fresh gales from S W steering E by S by compass at 4 P.M. wind hauled S W close reef last part strong gales with rain hauled to under close reef mainmast
