Tuesday Nov 26

Began with calm weather and raining middle light was from the Northward. Last part strong breeze took in gallant sail spoke buoy Henry of Age. Began received the house
Thus Ends at Obser

Wednesday Nov 27

Began with light gales from N.W. heading S.E. Doubled reef the topsails at 12 hours on heavy took in sail last part gale abated at the forecastle
Thus Ends at Obser

Thursday Nov 28

Came with light gales from the Northward with a rough sea set Doubled reef topsails at night calm and clear at 12 light breeze from West steering S.W. & with all sail set last part fresh breeze and pleasant saw a ship standing to the Westward
Thus Ends

Friday Nov 29

Began with fresh breeze from S.W. with pleasant weather heading S.E. by S with all sail set at midnight fresh gales close reef the topsails last part weather more moderate made all sail
Thus Ends
Lat 32-20 Long 53-00

Saturday Nov 30

Began with fresh breeze from Westward foggy steering S.W. & with gallant sails set last part light breeze from South sent Main royal yard aloft set shudding sail
Thus Ends
Lat 32-50 Long 51-30

Sunday 1st December

Came with small winds from South steering S.W. & with all sail set last part fresh gales and finally took in gallant sails
Thus Ends
Lat 31-50 Long 49-40

Monday Dec 1

Came with fresh gales from S.W. steering S.W. & Doubled reef the topsails at 4 P.M. wind hauled to the Southward moderate made all sail then the night strong breeze with dark dry weather last part fresh gales with frequent squalls saw a ship on the weather bow hauled the same way
Thus Ends
Lat 48-30 Long 47-30

Tuesday Dec 2

Began with fresh gales from S.W. attended with heavy hail squalls steering S.W. & with all sail set at 4 P.M. took in shudding sail top gallant sail then ship South Boston Fair Haven under all sail shudding sail set and royal trying how far he could carry sail then the night strong gales with heavy squalls last part gale abated
Thus Ends
Lat 46-20 Long 44-58

Wednesday Dec 3

Came with fresh gales from S.W. with frequent squalls steering S.E. by S with topsails set middle weather the same last part weather more moderate wind that with frequent rain squalls
Thus Ends
