

Bound to the Eastward of the Grand Banks

Sunday July 6

Came with pleasant breeze from West steering East saw a large herring to the Northward last part calm two sails in sight Thus Ends
Lat 39° 40' Long 62° 54'

Monday July 7

Begins with calm weather last part pleasant breeze from South steering E N E. saw number of herring one sail in sight steering to the Eastward Thus Ends
Lat 39° 47' Long 61° 12'

Tuesday July 8

Came with light breeze from South and pleasant weather steering E N E the rest part of this 24 hours weather the same saw a school of blackfish going quick toward for them did not get past Thus Ends
Lat 41° 00' Long 68° 15'

Wednesday July 9

Begins with pleasant breeze from South steering E N E threw the night heavy rain last part pleasant saw a school of blackfish toward took four Thus Ends The Day
Lat 41° 30' Long 68° 10'

Thursday July 10

Begins with light breeze from S W with fog last part weather the same one main broke out with the mizzen Thus Ends
Lat 42° 2' Long 64° 00'

Friday July 11

Begins with light breeze from west steering E by S threw the night foggy last part clear weather Thus Ends
Lat 42° 55' Long 61° 25'

Bound for Western Islands

Saturday July 12

Came with light breeze from West and pleasant weather steering E by S mizzen and last part foggy Thus Ends No Observe
By Acc Lat 43° 00' Long 48° 00'

Sunday July 13

Begins with moderate breeze from S W with fog steering East by Compass the rest part of these 24 hours weather the same Thus Ends No Observe
By Acc Lat 43° 20' Long 44° 30'

Monday July 14

Came with light breeze from S W with thick fog steering East by S with all sail set saw plenty of porpoises last part pleasant weather infrequent steering again saw Thus Ends The Day
Lat 44° 00' Long 41° 28'

Tuesday July 15

Came with light breeze from West steering E by S employed steering spars last part calm one sail in sight Lat 44° 10' Long 40° 00'

Wednesday July 16

Begins with light breeze from West with pleasant weather steering E by S last part weather the same Lat 44° 26' Long 37° 15'

Thursday July 17

First part light breeze from S W steering E by S last part fresh breeze and foggy saw two finbacks and porpoises Thus Ends
Lat 44° 46' Long 34° 40'

Friday July 18

Came with strong breeze E S E blows on fresh with squalls double reef the topsails mizzen led a heavy squall wind hauled S W ahead off two finbacks and grass porpoises Lat 45° 13' Long 29° 51'
