Commenced with pleasant breeze from S.W. heading S by E last part weather the same two sails in sight Lat 24.20 Long 24.36

Sunday August 10

All these 24 hours light air from S.W. and pleasant weather one sail in sight Lat 23.47 Long 23.57

Monday Aug 11

All these 24 hours light air and calm weather two sails in sight Lat 23.18 Long 23.21

Tuesday August 12

All this day calm weather picked up a large stick of pine timber Lat 22.57 Long 22.32

Wednesday Aug 13

All these 24 hours light air and calm weather three sails in sight Lat 22.15 Long 22.33

Thursday Aug 14

Begins with light air from N.E. at night fine breeze set to sea and lower studding sail last part fresh trade and pleasant employed picking over mizzen Lat 21.50 Long 22.08

Friday Aug 15

Begins with fresh trade and pleasant weather at 4 P.M. saw a school of sperm whale ~~the~~ going quick N.W. & bore showed them till night gave them up at night stood to the northward on the wind in hope of seeing them in the morning at 6 A.M. were ship headed S.E. till dark saw nothing left of on sea Lat 21.50 Long 22.41

Saturday August 16

Begins with fresh trade from S.E. steering S by W per compass last part weather the same Ends Lat 21.20 Long 22.23

Sunday August 17

Strong trade and pleasant weather steering S by W Ends the same Lat 20.20 Long 22.25

Monday Aug 18

fresh trade and pleasant weather steering S by W at part windy light hauld more to the Northward Lat 19.40 Long 23.00

Tuesday Aug 19

Begins with moderate breeze from the Northward steering S by W per compass last part weather the same Ends Lat 19.19 Long 23.41

Wednesday August 20

Moderate breeze from N.E. steering S by W per compass saw 2 bark steering N.W. at 4 P.M. Island of Antone having true course S by W 1/2 S Dist 111 miles middle end last part light air and smoky weather Lat 17.24 Long 24.40

Thursday Aug 21

Calm with light air from N.E. steering S by W at 4 P.M. saw Island of Antone having West dist 15 miles at night lay aback at 10 went in shore got 6 men brought aboard landed 2 of the passengers at Saint Antone Begins 8.00
