 to sea

Tuesday Aug 27th
 Begins with light breeze and pleasant
 weather at night Breeze S.W. 10° E
 sent 16 miles two sails in sight last
 part pleasant breeze from East one sail
 in sight
 Thus Ends
 Lat 13° 45' Long 25° 10'

 Begins with light breeze from East and
 shifting a squall bearing from South at
 night light breeze from S.E. and cloudy bearing
 S.W. middle and last part light breeze and calm
 sail in sight
 Lat 12° 50' Long 24° 59'

Thursday August 28th
 Came with light breeze from East steering S.W. & saw three
 sails bound to the northward middle and last part calm
 light and shifting
 Lat 11° 15' Long 24° 50'

Friday August 29th
 Begins with light breeze from East steering South
 at 2 P.M. spoke ship Francis Thompson
 New Bedford was about of her came on
 heavy squalls with rain came aboard with the
 squalls at night calm and heavy bearing
 weather last part light breeze from West
 Lat 11° 20' Long 24° 50'

Sat Aug 30th
 Came with light breeze from West steering
 East in company with ship Henry Elder
 New Bedford then the night heavy rain
 and squally
 Lat 11° 40' Long 24° 50'

Sunday Aug 31st
 Begins with squally weather wind W.S. 10° E
 heading S.W. & then the night heavy squalls
 with rain last part fresh breeze and pleasant
 weather
 Thus Ends
 Lat 9° 50' Long 23° 15'

Monday Sept 1st
 Begins with pleasant breeze from S.E. 20°
 heading S.E. last part middle the same at 10 o'clock
 16 miles a large square sail going parallel to
 the Eastward bound did not get near him
 ship Francis Thompson in sight Lat 8° 50' Long 22° 10'
