Tuesday September 1st
 Comm with pleasant breeze from S.W. & W
 chased the whale till 2 o'clock and gave him
 up middle and last part strong breeze and squally
 weather Thus Ends
 Lat 7-15 Long 19-15

Wednesday Sept 2
 Begins with strong breeze from S.S.W. heading
 S.E. ship Henry & the remains in sight
 middle and last part baffling winds and
 squally weather three sails in sight
 Lat 6-10 Long 17-30

Thursday Sept 3
 Begins with baffling winds from South and
 squally weather at 4 P.M. took ship heading
 off by S at 5 A.M. stood on the other tack
 heading S.E. by compass three sails in
 sight Lat 5-50 Long 17-00

Friday Sept 4
 Comm with moderate breezes from S.S.W. heading
 S.E. three sails in sight middle and last part
 strong breezes and cloudy weather Thus Ends
 Lat 4-14 Long 15-49

Saturday Sept 5
 Begins with fresh breezes and cloudy weather
 wind S.S.W. heading S.E. last part light airs
 and clear weather three sails in sight Lat 3-24 Long 15-00

Sunday Sept 6
 Begins with light airs from S.S.W. heading S.E. saw
 a school of blackfish headed for me middle and
 last part weather the same saw plenty of
 blackfish but did not succeed in getting two 1 sails in
 sight Lat 4-00 Long 12-00

Bound to the Northwest

Monday Sept 7
 Comm with light breezes from S.W. heading S.E. by
 compass saw blackfish but did not get fast middle wind
 the same last part light breezes from S.S.W. and squally
 lacked ship heading West three sails in sight saw blackfish
 Lat 3-10 Long 10-30

Tuesday Sept 8
 Begins with fresh breezes and squally wind S.S.W. by
 compass heading West at night winds steadily and clear
 weather last part weather the same three sails in sight
 Thus Ends Lat 2-31 Long 13-45

Wednesday Sept 9
 Comm with strong breezes from S.S.W. heading West saw blackfish
 three sails in sight last part moderate breezes and pleasant
 weather two sails in sight heading to the southward and
 westward Lat 1-55 Long 15-45

Thursday Sept 10
 Begins with moderate breezes from South and pleasant
 weather heading W by S by compass last part winds
 S.S.E. heading S.W. Lat 1-15 Long 16-57

Friday Sept 11
 All these 24 hours light breezes from S.E. and pleasant
 weather sent down galley masts sent and one for and
 main stomp & mizen two sails in sight
 Lat 0-15 Long 15-00

Saturday Sept 12
 All this day light breezes from S.E. and pleasant weather
 heading S.W. Lat 1-01 Long 18-25

Sunday Sept 13
 All these 24 hours fine breezes from S.E. and pleasant
 weather heading S.W. saw a large ship steering to the
 Northward Lat 2-28 Long 19-30
 Variation 19 miles Westward
