Monday September 15th 1851
All these 24 hours fair breeze from S.E. and pleasant
weather heading S.W. by compass saw blackfish bones
got one Lat 41° 14' Long 21° 40'

Tuesday Sept 16
All this day fair breeze from S.E. and pleasant
weather heading S.W. Lat 41° 31' Long 21° 55'

Wednesday Sept 17
Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather
at night baffling winds with frequent squalls
attended with rain took in flying jib and
main royal but put strong breezes and pleasant
weather saw a black bound to the blackboard
Lat 41° 15' Long 22° 50'

Thursday Sept 18
All these 24 hours strong breeze from S.E. by S and
pleasant weather Lat 41° 50' Long 24° 12'

Friday Sept 19
Begins with strong breezes from S.E. and pleasant
weather heading S.W. at 8 A.M. mason to patch sheets
patched sheet the topsail took in foretop gallant
last part baffling winds and squally imployed
repairing mason to patch Lat 42° 50' Long 24° 50'

Saturday Sept 20
Begins with baffling winds from E.S.E. and
S.E. attended with squalls but the mason
topsail last part moderate breeze with a heavy swell on
Lat 43° 15' Long 25° 30'

Brown Towards Western Islands

Sunday Sept 21
Comm with light breezes from S.E. with a heavy swell
on heading S.W. last part light and baffling
Lat 46° 41' Long 26° 29'

Monday Sept 22
Begins with light and from S.E. heading S.W. at night winds
from south and squally heading W.S.W. middle and last
part light gales from the southward heading W.S.W.
under double reef topsails This Ends The Day
Lat 47° 24' Long 27° 49'

Tuesday Sept 23
Begins with fresh gales from the southward heading
W.S.W. last part fresh breezes and pleasant weather
wrecker imployed shaking a lot of old pipes
This Ends Lat 48° 32' Long 28° 50'

Wednesday Sept 24
Comm with fresh breezes from S.E. and pleasant weather
a heavy swell bearing from south ship heading S.W.
at 8 A.M. saw Martin bas rocks on the lee beam dist
15 miles regulated the chronometer found it 5th secant
to fast for greenwich bar water 120° slow losing 2nd
This Ends Lat 49° 36' Long 29° 50'

Thursday Sept 25
Begins with pleasant breezes from E.S.E. steering
S.W. with all sail set saw finbacks last part with
on the same wind East saw a ship steering to the southward
Ends Lat 50° 52' Long 29° 12'

Friday Sept 26
Comm with pleas breezes from south East steering
S.W. with all sail set last part light and
squally took in the lachane mason to repair
Lat 50° 03' Long 29° 19'
