Come with fresh breezes from S.W. and thick weather steering S.E. by E with all sail set last part fresh gales from west and squally
lat 36.40 Long 10.15

Thursday Oct 16

Begins with fresh gales and squally weather from West at 4 P.M. wine hauls S.W. took in gallant masts Doubtless lost the topmasts middle weather now moderate last winds light and variable
This Ends at 11 Ob
By Acc lat 36.40 Long 12.10

Friday Oct 17

Come with light breezes from S.S.W. steering S.E. by E with all sail set middle and last part fresh breezes from South and clear weather saw finbacks men employed repairing a mainmast Ends
lat 36.27 Long 18.30

Saturday Oct 18

Begins with strong breezes from the southward and variable attended with a smooth sea heading E & S last part light breezes and pleasant weather saw thousands of finbacks
lat 36.24 Long 18.45

Come with pleasant breezes from S.W. steering S.E. saw plenty of finbacks at 8 P.M. there no sail Doubtless lost the topmasts last part strong gales from South took in jib and mainmast & fore topmasts at 10 gale abated set topmasts when 11 this is how had a strong current setting to the southward lat 36.24 Long 20.10
