

Ship Climate New London

Thursday Oct 30

Came with light air an variable from the Eastward at moderate wind hauled to the Northward steering S E by E per compass last part winds most of the time from N W with sudden gusts Ends lat 34° 02' Long 46° 25'

Friday Oct 31

Begins with ^{fast gales} from N W and cloudy weather steering S E by E per compass saw finbacks at 6 P.M. gale increasing double with the sunset last part wind about the same attended with heavy rains Ends No Observations By sea lat 35° 40' Long 47° 30'

Saturday Oct November 1

Came with fresh gales from N W with heavy rains steering S E by E at 1 P.M. wind shifted S S W in a heavy rain squall which soon increased to a heavy gale at 4 P.M. too to under a close reef main topmast at 6 P.M. gale abated soon set double reef topmast late at steering East with plenty of porpoises last part fresh gales from South with rough sea Ends No All Lat 35° 05' Long by sea 48° 20'

Sunday Nov 2

Begins with fresh gales from South steering East with double reef topmasts set caught two porpoises middle and last part much light and variable Spent Evening Lat 35° 30' Long 48° 56'

Monday Nov 3

Begins with variable winds from the Eastward and squally saw porpoises last part weather the same Lat 36° 14' Long 49° 30'

Tuesday Nov 4

Came with fresh breezes from East heading S by E with single reef topmasts set last part fresh gales from E N E Lat 37° 54' Long 52° 40'

Wednesday Nov 5

Begins with fresh gales from E N E heading S E at 8 P.M. hauled in jib and mainmast last part strong gale with rainy weather took in fore and mizen topmast Ends No Observations By sea lat 38° 00' Long 54° 00'

Thursday Nov 6

Came with fresh gales from N E with heavy weather heading S E at 8 P.M. wind hauled to the Northward in a squall which soon after moderated last part light breezes from N W and clear weather a heavy squall bearing from the Eastward Lat 38° 24' Long 55° 00'

Friday Nov 7

Begins with light breezes from N W steering E by S with all sail set the rest part of the 24 hours weather the same saw finbacks and porpoises Ends lat 37° 50' Long 57° 25' Direction 2 1/2 Points the half

Saturday Nov 8

Came with pleasant breezes from West steering E by S per compass saw finbacks last part light air from South Lat 37° 15' Long 59° 30'
