Sunday Nov 10

Began with pleasant breeze from N.E. heading S.E. by E. for Campbell saw finbacks and porpoises last part weather the same Lat 57.34 Long 64.15

Tuesday Nov 11

Began with pleasant breeze from N.E. heading East saw finbacks last part no alteration in the weather Lat 56.28 Long 66.46

Wednesday Nov 12

Came with pleasant breeze from the Northward steering East with all sail set saw finbacks. A M. saw a ship on the weather quarter standing to the Eastward at 6 P.M. spoke ship America New Bedford 3 months out so M. term Ends M. Lat
Lat 56.36 Long by day 69.45

Thursday Nov 13

Began with light breeze from N.W. attended with rain at night steering E. by S. by compass last part light breeze from Southward steering East saw finbacks and porpoises Lat 56.10 Long 71.20

Friday Nov 14

Came with light breeze from the Southward heading East middle calm last part light breeze from West saw finbacks Lat 54.00 Long 72.20

Saturday Nov 15

Came with light breeze from West steering S.E. by S saw finbacks last part fresh breeze from S.E. with thick weather heading S.E. Ends M. Observation
By day Lat 55.30 Long 74.40

Sunday Nov 16

Began with fresh breeze from the Southward attended with thick weather heading S.E. middle and last part winds shifting a heavy swell heaving from the South Lat 56.00 Long 76.10

Monday Nov 17

Began with moderate breeze from N.W. steering S.E. by E with all sail set middle blow fresh with rain last part light gale and thick squally weather at 12 wind hauled S.W. cleared off saw Amsterdam Island bearing West 10 miles Thus Ends Lat 57.48
Long 77.25 Chronometer fast

Tuesday Nov 18

Came with light breeze from N.W. heading South at 4 P.M. tacked ship heading N.W. for the Island at 8 P.M. land bore N.W. by W. 10 miles A.M. three boats went in shore fishing last part fresh breeze and pleasant weather Thus Ends

Began with fresh breeze from the Westward and pleasant at night laying off and on with the land A.M. sent the boats in fishing last part fresh breeze and pleasant weather saw 4 ships here fishing Thus Ends The Ship
