Friday Nov 21

Begins with light breeze from S.W. at night had to head from the Northward Steering E.S.E. last part fresh breeze from S.W. and clear weather
Lat 38°43' Long 85°20'

Saturday Nov 22

fresh breeze from S.W. and pleasant weather Steering E.S.E. in company with ship Jefferson made fresh gales at 6 A.M. saw plenty of finbacks Double reef the topsails saw north that looked like a right whale help off on a course Ends at 11 A.M.
Lat 38°40' Long 89°50'

Sunday Nov 23

Came with fresh gales and thick weather Steering E.S.E. with Double reef topsails set saw plenty of finbacks last part moderate breeze and pleasant saw thousands of finbacks Lat 39°01' Long 90°00'

Monday Nov 24

Begins with pleasant breeze from S.W. steering S.E. by E. in company with ship Jefferson saw finbacks last part light breeze from S.E. heading E.S.E. saw finbacks Lat 39°18' Long 92°05'

Thursday Nov 25

Begins with light breeze from S.E. heading E.S.E. men employed repairing the mainmast carpenter employed making the fore hatch larger saw finbacks last part fresh breeze from S.E. with sun rain Ends
Lat 39°27' Long 95°30'

Wednesday Nov 26

Strong breeze from S.E. heading S.E. by E. saw finbacks in company with ship Jefferson New London then the night thick weather with rain last part ahead up saw plenty of finbacks wind West S.W. Ends at 11 O'clock
By Sea Lat 39°40' Long 99°00'

Thursday Nov 27

Came with moderate gales from W.S.W. steering E.S.E. with Double reef topsails set saw plenty of finbacks at 8 P.M. spoke ship Jefferson New London middle and last part moderate breeze and pleasant weather Ends Lat 40°56' Long 99°14'

Friday Nov 28

Begins with pleasant breeze from the Westward steering E.S.E. saw plenty of finbacks at sundown saw one right whale heard got fast came on deck and had to cut last part heavy rain and thick weather Ends By Sea
Lat 40°56' Long 99°00'

Saturday Nov 29

Begins with moderate breeze from the Northward with rain went aboard ship Jefferson and had a game at night wind hauld west and ahead off took in sail at 11 A.M. set Double reef topsails help off E.S.E. saw nothing but finbacks Ends Lat 40°56' Long 100°00'
