

Ship Clementis Kaitiaki

Sunday November 20th 1831

Came with pleasant breeze from S.W. steering
E.S.E. saw plenty of finbacks last part strong breeze
from N.W. with cloudy weather saw finbacks

Thus Ends 1st Observation
By Sec Lat 40° 40' Long 108° 40'

Monday December 1st
Began with light gales from S.W. with thick
weather steering E.S.E. and Ends the same
Lat 40° 34' Long by Sec 107° 20'

Tuesday December 2nd

Begins with gales from W.S.W. steering E.S.E.
Saw finbacks middle and hauld West in a heavy
small squall the main left galleons last part
heavy gales with a high sea took in West
last

Ends Lat 40° 20' Long 111° 20'

Wednesday Dec 3rd

Came with heavy gales from West steering E.S.E.
with Double reef topsails set last part moderat
gales with thick weather wind hauld more to the
Northward

Ends Lat 41° 15' Long 115° 10'

Thursday Dec 4

first breeze from N.W. steering E.S.E. with main
galleons set saw finbacks mid night blows on
heavy Double reef the topsails last part heavy gales
and clear weather Lat 41° 20' Long 119° 50'

Friday Dec 5

Begins with heavy gales from S.W. with a
high sea heavy squalls occasionally steering
E.S.E. with close reef topsails set last part gale abated
wind hauld S.W. Thus Ends Lat 42° 00' Long 123° 00'

Bround Towards Vanuatu Land

Saturday December 6th 1831

Begins with strong breeze from S.W. steering E.S.E.
with all sail set middle and last part weather about the
same saw plenty of finbacks men employed repairing
and old galleons set

Ends Lat 42° 20' Long 126° 40'

Sunday Dec 7

Came with strong winds from S.W. steering E.S.E.
at night blows on heavy Double reef the topsails last
part heavy gales with high sea Ends Lat 43° 00' Long 130° 40'

Monday Dec 8

Begins with heavy gales from S.W. steering East with
Double reef topsails set last part gale abated
passed ship the topsails hauled fore lying to
Ends Lat 42° 28' Long 134° 20'

Tuesday Dec 9

Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. with a
breeze seen on steering East middle fresh gales
from W.S.W. last part heavy gales from West and
raining

Ends Lat 43° 20' Long 138° 15'

Wednesday Dec 10

Came with fresh breezes from West and squally from
E.S.E. with Double reef topsails set at night wind
hauld S.W. last part wind hauld S.W.

Ends Lat 44° 11' Long 141° 10'

Thursday Dec 11

Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. and overcast
weather steering E.S.E. the rest part of these 24 hours
weather the same

Ends No Observation
By Sec Lat 44° 20' Long 145° 00'
