Begins with pleasant breeze from the Northward
saw an English Brigg steering West last
part wind and weather the same ship
to windward heading to the Eastward

Calm with strong winds from the Northward
heading East saw a Brigg steering N. W. S. W.
at night blow on fresh Southward with the
tapsails last part wind about the same with
cloudy weather in morning picking over potatoes

Monday Jan 19

Calm with light breeze from S. W. steering N. E. by N.
last part of the night calm last part squalls from S. W.
men fighting and raising the ship Thus Ends
Lat 34° 15' Long 165° 20'

Tuesday Jan 20

Begins with light air from S. W. steering N. E. a
heavy swell having from the Eastward middle moderate
breeze last part calm Thus Ends
Lat 35° 15' Long 166° 50'

Wednesday Jan 21

Begins with calm weather at 2 P. M. saw
heavy tide repps saw three sperm whales
near them carrying heavy repps of one Dotted
Did not get fast the whale is think would make
a hundred lbs but better luck next time what
is done can't be helped then the light had
moderate breeze from S. W. with squalls occasional
steer back and forth on the wind till morning
saw nothing more of them till off at 8 P. M.
