Friday Jan 23
Begins with hawking winds from S.W. with heavy rain squalls steering N.E. middle and last part pleasant breeze and clear weather
Lat 29° 45' Long 169° 57'

Saturday Jan 24
Came with pleasant breezes from S.W. steering N.E. with all sail set last part weather the same wind West
Lat 27° 54' Long 171° 28'

Sunday Jan 25
Begins with pleasant breezes from ~~East~~ steering North with all sail set middle squally attended with rain wind hauled to the Southward
Lat 25° 20' Long 172° 14'

Monday Jan 26
Came with pleasant breezes from the Southward steering North with all sail set last part light breeze with a heavy swell bearing from South
Lat 23° 22' Long 172° 25'

Tuesday Jan 27
Begins with light breeze from South steering North at night hauled up N.E. to clear and Island last part light breeze and clear weather employed painting the starboard side of the ship
Lat 22° 50' Long 173° 05'

Wednesday Jan 28
Came with light breeze from the Southward steering North and ends the same
Lat 21° 00' Long 173° 15'

Thursday Jan 29
Pleasant breeze from South steering North Ends the same
Lat 19° 41' Long 173° 35'

Bound to Guam

Friday Jan 30
Begins with pleasant breezes from South steering North with all sail set employed raising new longboats to the main rigging last part fresh breeze from S.E. and squally weather
Lat 17° 25' Long 173° 24'

Saturday January 31
Came with strong winds from S.E. and squally weather steering North with single reef topsails set middle and last part pleasant weather set all sail
Then Ends the Atlantic
Lat 14° 15' Long by Acc 170° 20'

Sunday Jan February 1
Came with pleasant breeze from S.E. steering North with all sail set at night came on squally attended with heavy rains middle pleasant with heavy squalls of rain last part light winds and hawking breeze
By Doubt Lat 12° 18' Long 170° 9'

Monday February 2
Came with light breeze from S.E. and rainy weather at night calm with frequent rain squalls last part light breeze from East
Lat 12° 07' Long 172° 53'

Tuesday Feb 3
Came with light winds from East steering N.W. last part calm to 10.30 long run

Wednesday Feb 4
Begins with calm weather at 6 P.M. had a heavy squall from West with plenty of rain then the night all kinds of weather last part light breeze from N.W. with cloudy weather
