Begins with brisk breezes from N. E. and rainy, heading N. N. W. under a double reefed main topsail and foresail, middle part strong breezes and squally, with heavy falls of rain, latter part wind from N. to N. E. with heavy rain heading to the Eastward under a double reefed main topsail and fore spencer. Bar. 30.1.  
So ends. Lat. By D. R. 22. 50. Long. By D. R. 106. 05. 00.

Saturday July 1<sup>st</sup> 1854.

Commences with wind from N. N. E. to N. W. and rainy heading from E. to N. N. E. under a double reefed main topsail and fore spencer, middle part wind from the S. W. and more pleasant, latter part light breezes from S. S. W. and pleasant weather, heading to the Westward under all sail, and saw a sulphur bottom. Bar. 30.2.  
So ends these 24 hours. Lat. By obs. 22. 42. Long. By Lunar. 105. 30. 15. Sun. W.

Sunday July 2<sup>nd</sup> 1854.

Begins with light breezes from the Southward heading to the Westward under all sail, saw several finbacks, middle and latter part very light airs from E. S. E. to E. N. E. and pleasant. Bar. 30.2.

Monday July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1854.

Commences with calms and very light baffling airs from the Southward, middle and latter part light breezes from the E. S. E. and pleasant heading to the Southward, and broke out a cask of beef. Bar. 30.2+.

Tuesday July 4<sup>th</sup> 1854.

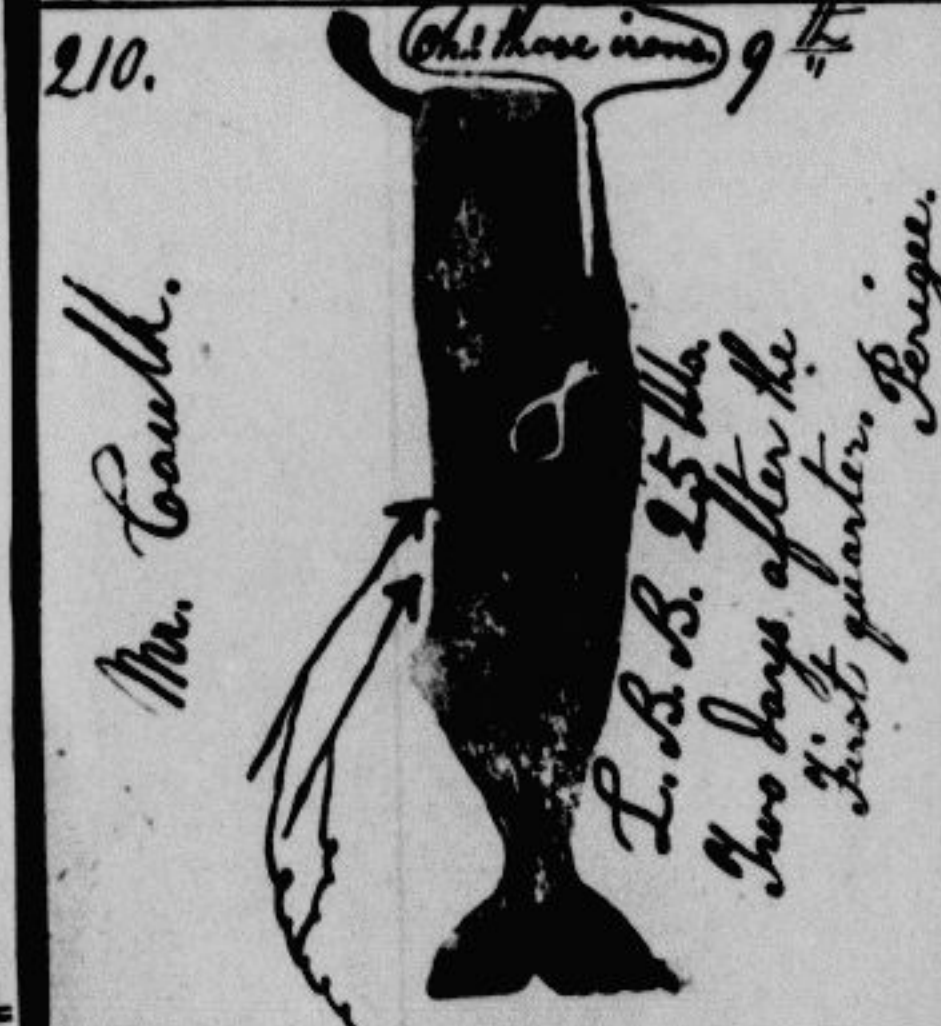
Begins with very light breezes from the S. E. heading S. W. by S. under all sail except the fore top gallant sail, and set up the fore stay, middle part steering S. E. by S. under easy sail with light breezes from E. N. E. latter part light breezes from the S. W. and pleasant steering the same course, set up the main stay and main topmast stay. Bar. 30.2+.  
So ends. Lat. By obs. 23. 15. Long. By obs. 106. 08. 15.

Main S. Cross tree.

Wednesday July 5<sup>th</sup> 1854.

Commences with a calm, two sails in sight, the watch employed setting up the head stays, the carpenter put up a new main top gallant cross tree, middle and latter part light breezes from S. S. W. and S. heading to the Westward, at 11 A. M. saw a body of sperm whales working to the N. W. lowered three boats and gave chase, at noon the boats away from the ship. Bar. 30.2.

Thursday July 6<sup>th</sup> 1854.

Begins with moderate breezes from the Southward, and some squally, at about 3 P. M. the larboard boat took a whale to the ship, the other boats chased the school several miles without success, at about 4 P. M. hooked to the whale at 4 P. M. finished cutting, rather hard siege for a small whale, middle part rainy, latter part strong breezes from the S. E. and squally with showers of rain, at 11 A. M. had the head cleared away ready for washing the decks. Bar. 30.3.  
So ends. Lat. By obs. 23. 23. Long. By obs. 104. 57. 30.

Friday July 7<sup>th</sup> 1854.

Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E. and some squally heading to the S. S. W. under a close reefed main topsail and foresail, at about 2 P. M. started the fires, and broached a new shovel, middle part carrying the same sail, latter part more moderate set double reefed topsails, jib and spencer, heading to the Southward and employed boiling, saw two finbacks. Bar. 30.3.
