E. heading to the Eastward under double reefed topsails and courses, two sails in sight. Do ends &c. Lat. By obs. 26° 26'. Bar. 30.1.

Cotton Main Topsail.

Thursday March 29th 1855.

Begins with light breezes from W. S. W. heading to the Southward under all sail except the fore top gallant sail sent down the cotton main topsail to repair and bent a hoop one in its place, middle part moderate, latter part very light breezes from W. S. W. heading to the Southward, and employed middle stitching the cotton main topsail.

Do ends &c. Lat. By obs. 26° 23'. Long. By Δ 110° 12' 00". Bar. 30.0.

Break out.

Friday March 30th 1855.

Commenced with very light breezes from S. S. W. and pleasant heading to the S. E. and bent the cotton main topsail again, saw a school of porpoises, middle part carrying double reefed topsails, latter part moderate breezes from the Southward heading W. by S. with the main top gallant sail set, employed breaking out for slops and small stores. Do ends &c. Lat. By obs. 26° 26'. Long. By Δ 107° 19' 30". Bar. 30.0. +.

New Boat.

Saturday March 31st 1855.

Begins with brisk breezes from S. S. W. heading W. with the main top gallant sail out, middle and latter part moderate breezes from S. S. E. to S. heading to the S. W. employed fitting a new boat overhead for whaling, four whalers in sight. Do ends &c. Lat. By obs. 26° 40'. Long. By Δ 108° 19' 15". Bar. 30.1.

Carcase.

Sunday April 1st 1855.

Commenced with light breezes from S. heading to the W. S. W. and passed a whale's carcase, one Ship, and three Barks in sight, middle and latter part very light breezes from the S. E. and pleasant, three whalers in sight. Do ends &c. Lat. By obs. 26° 55'. Long. By Δ 107° 47' 30". Bar. 30.2. +.

Merchant Ship.

Monday April 2nd 1855.

Begins with very light airs from the S. E. and pleasant, heading S. S. W. saw a merchant Ship standing to the Northward, middle part very light airs, latter part light breezes from the Westward steering S. E. two sails in sight. Do ends &c. Lat. By obs. 26° 55'. Long. By Δ 108° 00'. Bar. 30.2. +.

Breach.

Tuesday March 27th 1855.

Begins with brisk breezes from the Southward heading E. and E. by S. two sails in sight to windward, middle part moderate, latter part light breezes from S. S. E. heading to the Eastward under all sail and saw a breach. Do ends &c. Lat. By obs. 26° 08'. Long. By Δ 109° 35' 00". Bar. 30.0.

Sulphur Bottom.

Wednesday March 28th 1855.

Commenced with brisk breezes from S. heading E. S. E. with the main top gallant sail out, and saw a sulphur bottom, middle part moderate, latter part light breezes from the S. W. heading S. S. E. The cooper employed making breakers. Do ends &c. Lat. By obs. 26° 10'. Long. By Δ 109° 57' 30". Bar. 29.9. +.
