Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong Breezes
From the S.E. to S.W. and Roney with a Large
Swell on at 2 Set the Fore sail and Close
Reef Top sail at 4 More Pleasant at 7 Took on
the Fore sail heading to the S.E. Eastward

Middle Part Squally at 11
Took in the Top sail

Latter Part Wind N.W.
at 5 Made Short Sail Standing to the S.W.
at 8 Stead S Wind N.W. with a bad Swell
Ends Cloudy and nothing seen Lat by Ob 36.24
Long by Chro 72.15
Lat by D.R. 36 16
Long by D.R. 72 26

Thursday May 30 1839

Commencement of these 24 Hours Cloudy
Over Head with distant Thunder in the S.E.
with the Sea More Moderate at 4 O'clock
Thermometer 78° at 7 Shorten Sail heading
N.W.

Middle Part Moderate and Pleasant

Latter Part Same at 4 P O'clock Made Sail
Standing to the S.W. Saw a Hermorphaedite
Brig to the N.E. at 8 O'clock Thermometer
Flood 68° at 9 79° Jack Ship Wind N.W.
Heading N. Got a bill of Altitude Long
71-46 at 11 O'clock Saw Black fish Load Could
not get on came on board So Ends this day
Thermometer 76°

Friday May 31 1839

Wind W heading N.W. at 1 Saw the spout of
a whale

Latter Part the Same at 4 P O'clock Made
Sail at 5 Took to the South at 6 Saw 5 sperm
whales spouts which proved to Grampooned Jack
Ship to the N.W. Wind W Thermometer 68 to 70
water air bout the Same Ends Pleasant

Saturday June 1 1839

This day Begins with fresh Breeze from the
S.W. heading N.W. and N.W. at 3 O'clock

Rane at 7 More Clear and Calm at 8
Latter Middle Part Squally at 8 Made all
Sail and Set Half watches at 10 Jack
Ship and Reef Wind N.W. Thermometer 68 to
69° W

Latter Part Moderate and Pleasant
all Sail Set Thermometer 68° at 7 64° W Wind
W heading S.W. at 10 Thermometer 69° and
Blue water Stead N.W. Green water 66°
Saw a sail a stein and one a An and weather Bow
So Ends this Day Lat by Ob 37.25 Long by Chro 71.49
