could not get on at 10 came on board to look
for more at 11 Porpoises under the Sea Caught

Monday June 3rd 1839

at Main Sail Brisk Breeze from the S.E. to S.S.E.
heading to the S.W. Water 66 at 8 14 Jack
Ship to the W. at 10 Jack Ship to the South and
Stormy Sea at 11 Jack Ship to W.S. Saw two Brigs
Standing to the South at 12 Thick and Stormy Jack
in all Proffer Sail

Tuesday June 4th 1839

This day begins with Thick Squally and Ruff
Weather at 3 Clock Jack Ship to the South at 6 Jack
Ship to the South Wind S.W. to S.E. at 7 Calm
Saw a whaling Scho on our weather beam
and a Sail on our Lee Quarter

Thick and Squally Thermometer 66 water all in a sheet of
fire

Latter Part More Moderate Thick with Little
Rain at 6 Saw our Scho again at 8 Short Main
Sail Wind & heading S.E. at 8 Jack Ship to the
North at 12 Got the Sun to End this Day Lat by Ob 36 50

Wednesday June 5th 1839

This day begins with Little Breeze from the S.E.
heading S.E. with and roller of a Sea from the
E at 3 Clock a large brig fast as sailing
S.W. at 5 Wind S at 6 W.S. Jack Ship
at 7 Shorten Sail Little air from the W.S.W.

Middle Part the same at 8 Wind W

Latter Part Brisk Breeze from the Westward
Main Sail at 6 Thermometer 66 heading S.W. Saw
12 Jack Standing to the S.W. Westward at 8 heading
South at 9 Went in the Edge of the Stream
Thermometer 76 Jack Ship to the North in 20 minutes
Thermometer 64 Green Water Lat by 36 23 Long at 8 Clock
73 at 9 Short S.E. J.W. Water 67 Ends Cloudy
with a shower of Sleet in Site Lat by Ob 36 33
Saw of fine any Gray Water this season Long by DR 73 24
Stream 77 Green 66 to 64 Long by Chro 72 46
for you can out of Stream in to Green to Cold for Whales any day
