This day begins with strong breezes from the West Steering E to W & water 68 to 70 Saw a number of pieces of squid Good water but no fish at 4 o'clock spoke the brig Robtson of Eastport from Sandamings Bound to Boston Gave him Maj Longtitude 71.30 Got his 72.00 at 7 Shorten Sail Haller My wind to the NW Wind WSW

Middle Part Wind and Weather Much the same

Latter Part Strong breeze cloudy and buff from W & E to W & E water 68 from 70 Gray So Ends this day

This day begins with strong breezes from the NW to W heading from E & E to W & E at 7 Shorten Sail heading NW to

Latter Part Wind NW at 4 p.m. Main Sail heading W & E to draw out of the Street 76.00 at 5 came out 68.00 heading W & E to W & E Lat the boats on the Lead cranes Ends with passing clouds

This day begins with brisk breezes from the NW heading to W & E to W & E for Sun a breeze a stem headed to the Eastward at 7 Shorten Sail heading to the NW Wind WSW

Cloudy Latter Part Strong breeze from the NW to W & E water 60 Main Short Sail Latt 39 08 Long 68 26 at bottom in 90 fathoms Keep off E & E to E & E Saw a finback One sail on one sea Beam So this day Ends More Moderate than at 4 o'clock Latt by Ab 39 22 Latt by DR 39 21 Long by DR 67 34 Long by DR 67 40

Thursday June 13 1839

Commencement of this day begins with cloudy from head and a brisk breeze NW to W heading E & E at 4 o'clock buff sea water 68 at 5 Bent the Foresail and close reef the Foresail Took up the boats

Middle Part More Moderate at 4 p.m. Little wind at 6 Calm

Latter Part Calm till 9 water Blue stood at 70.00 Saw a few flocks of birds and a finback heading E & E wind E & E So Ends this day
