Friday July the 5 1839

This day begins with lte breeze from the E
Heading west at 7 o'clock finishes stowing down
and Shorten Sail

Latter Part Wind E heading WNW
At 8 o'clock saw a pinkback Ends cloudy

Latt by Alt 38.50
Long by Chro 38.50

Saturday July the 6 1839
This day begins with fine pleasant weather Wind
E by S heading west at 7 Shorten Sail heading
W by E saw a large ship on our lee beam

Middle Part much the same

Latter Part the same at 7 o'clock tack ship
to the South saw Porpoises and 2 Sails on
each beam headed to the W Eastward E ends
this day

Long by Chro 39.16

Sunday July the 7 1839

This day begins with lte breeze from the E
Heading S at 7 saw a large ship on our
weather beam headed to the W with at 7 Shorten
Sail

Middle Part same heading to the
west

Latter Part calm saw Killis group
of isles and a sail a head at 9 got a Lunar
Long 38 2.8 by Chro 38 59 Latt by Alt 38 14
