

Friday July 12 1839

This day begins with Strong Breeze from N. W. heading S. W. Sat Single Reef Top Sail Fore Sail and Double Reefed Main Sail Rugged and Thick at times at 7 Done Ship and Shorten Sail

Middle Part Wind from N. to N. W.

Latter Part Same as the first Only more Pleasant Over Head Sat Single Reef Top Sail Jib and Double Reef Main Sail Heading E Wind from N. to E. & Saw a Ship on our Lee Beam with her Starboard Tacks on Board So Ends this day Water 67 to 69

Saturday July 13 1839

This day begins with Strong Breeze from the N. Eastward Heading E by S at 5 Struck a Porpoise and Broke the Iron and Lost him at 7 Shorten Sail and wore Ship Heading N. W.

Middle Part More Moderate

Latter Still the Same at 4 Made Sail Heading S. E & Wind N. and Squally Saw a Sail on our Weather Bow Heading E So Ends this day

Sunday July 14 1839

This day begins with Lite Breeze from the N. W. heading E by S Saw a Sail on our Weather Bow at 7 Shorten Sail and wore Round

Middle Part the Same

Latter Part Same as the first Heading E by S Saw a Grampus So Ends this day Calm Squalls

Monday July 15 1839

This day begins with Lite Breeze from the N. W. heading E by S at 7 O'clock Saw Black fish Load Starboard Boat faster and Drawn twice Starboard Boat got on Look at on Board and Shorten Sail Headed to the Foreward

Middle Part Same

Latter Part Moderate Breeze from the N. W. Headed E by S Saw a Sail a Stern 7 Saw Black fish Load Starboard Boat got on Look at along Side to for more B.C.
