This day begins Lite breeze from the SW at 7 o'clock the West End of St. Miguel. Bore S & E 1 1/2 Miles Jack Ship to the NW Middle Part Calm Latter Part Strong breeze from the SW Round down on the N Side of St. Miguel Saw 2 Briggs Steaming down on the W Side of St. Miguel at 12 were at Mid way So Ends this day

Tuesday July 30 1839

This day begins with Lite breeze from the SW NW at 8 o'clock East End of St. Miguel Bore SSW 2 Miles of spoke the shore of Anticosti Cape Bar 3 Months out of the Gamet a few Hours Headed S & E for the Cameris W

Latter Part Calm Saw a Ship 4 Miles to the westward So Ends this day Thick
