 day



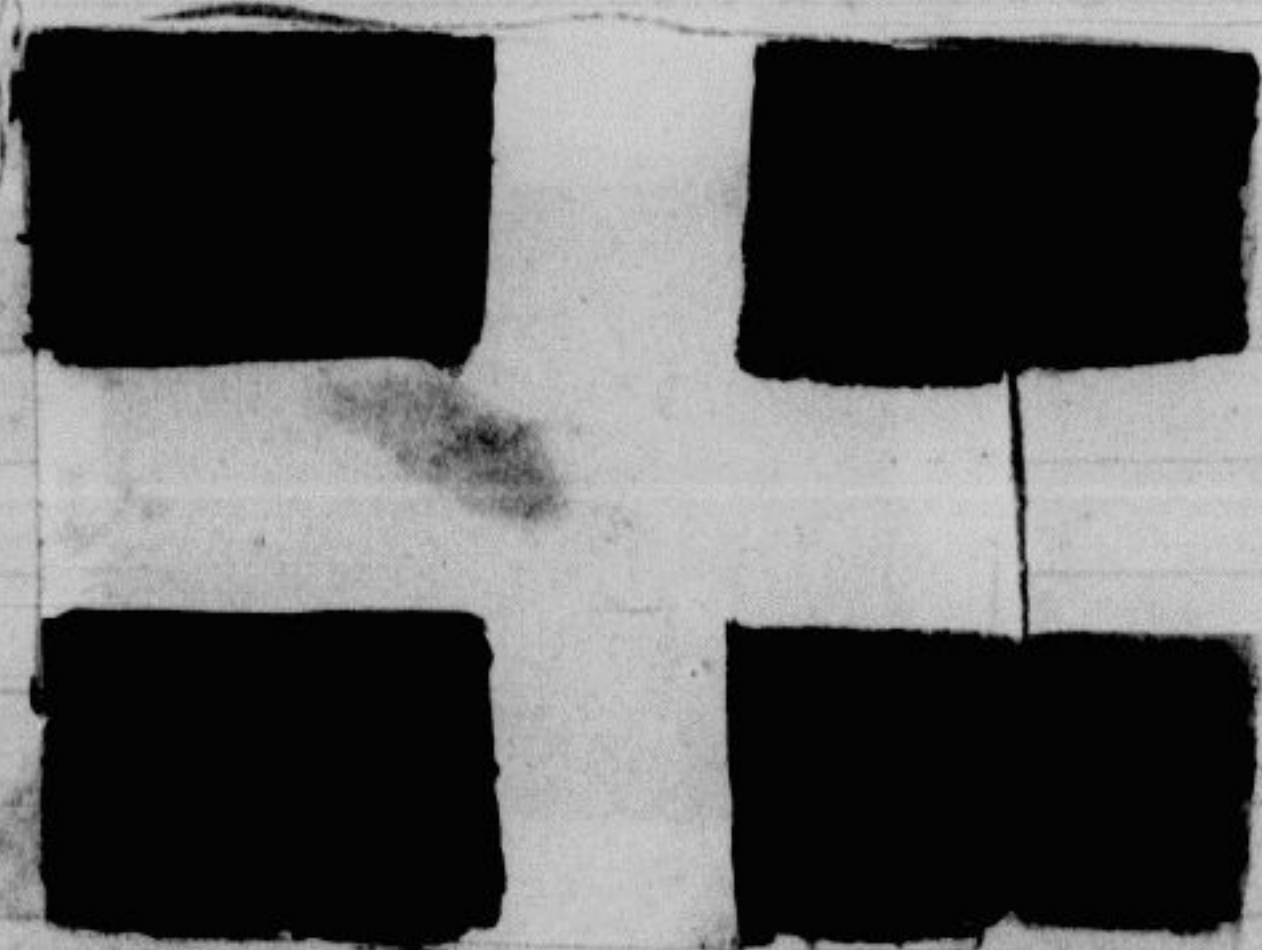

 Emer Moderate water 74°

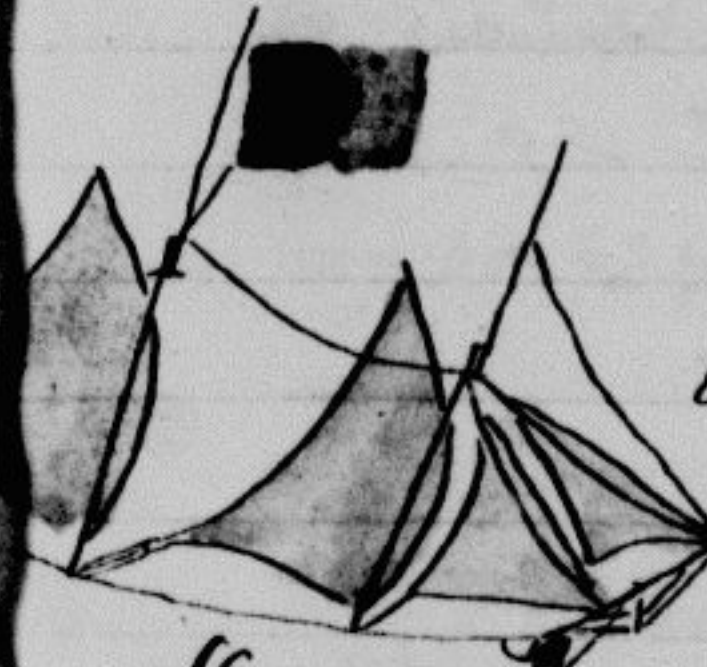
