Harden gave me some Paper which Saw 2 sails on her Lee bow So Ends this day

 Latter Part Lett Breeze from the ESE to E at 6 Made the Island of St. Antonio the Sugar Loaf being ESE by Comp Distance 21 Miles the best part of the Island being Enveloped in clouds Saw 5 ships and 2 brigs Steaming to the Southward this day also 10

 Headed by SE Saw 4 or 5 ships

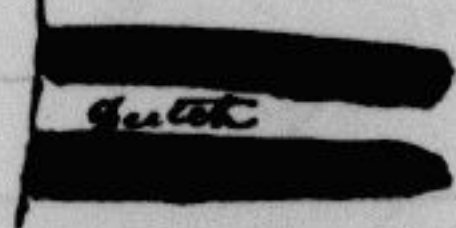

Tuesday August 20 1839
 This day begins with Lett breeze from the East
 Headed to SSE at 6 Squally Saw 10 sail

Latter Part Strong breeze from the ESE and Cloudy Saw a French ship and one Dutch ship And 7 more Headed to the SE towards 78° Headed to the SSE Variation 14, Points westerly

Latter Part Strong Breeze from the ESE at 11 O'clock Took the Wind & Headed to the SE 5 ships and a brig in sight Bound to the South End Cloudy and thick also 10
