Commencement of these 24 hours being between
to wind so of course we are in trouble with plenty
of company 4 ships in sight having the same
pleasure with us about by the strong waves
and no a breath of wind to day fresh But torrents
of rain from the heavens. So we are not grow about that
But rather feel happy to be so well of at 6 more
pleasant

at 10 Let air from SSW Headed to the SE at 2
Squally with the fog and mists

Latter Part Squally
and buff at 6 spoke a ship bound to New York Long
23.47 Saw a ship to seaward with her name Topmas Jon
and Miss Topgallant was as she made no signal in sight
On my course saw a ship on our weather bow Headed
to the SE Eastward Variation 1 1/4 Point Westerly So ends this day

Friday August 23 1859

This day begins with light breeze and squally
wind from WSW to SSE Headed to the SE
astward at 7 calm and torrents of rain made
Part wind and weather the same

Same wind SSW to W and squally
Lat by DR 12.13 Long 22.44 by DR Long 22.41

Saturday August 24 1859

This day begins with light breeze from the WSW and
cloudy Headed to the S. Saw the ship that lost main
topmast on our weather quarter Middle Part Wind SW
and Perry Let the S. Headed to the S Long 2 knots

Latter Part Pleasant and clear with the exception
of a few motionless clouds Water 80° Variation 1 1/4 Points
Westerly Lat by DR 11.37 Long by DR 22.40 Lat by Chr 10.48 Long by Chr 22.21

Sunday August 25 1859

Commencement with light breeze from the W
and pleasant

Middle Part the same

Latter Part fine light breeze from west Headed
S by W 1/4 W Variation 1 1/4 Points westerly at 6 Saw 2 sails
at stem on cone our weather beam Headed to the W
So ends this day Water 80° Lat by DR 10.07 Long by DR 22.40 Long by Chr 21.54

Monday August 26 1859

Commencement of this day fine pleasant weather
with a light breeze from the W by S Headed S by S
at 1 Observed a whale ship past under our lee Headed
to the S

Middle Part Squally wind WSW to W at
9 Observed the Condor past within half Headed to the
S

Latter Part Wind and weather the same
at 6 Saw a sail a head on our weather beam
and 2 at stem Headed South Water 80° Ends clear
day and squally
